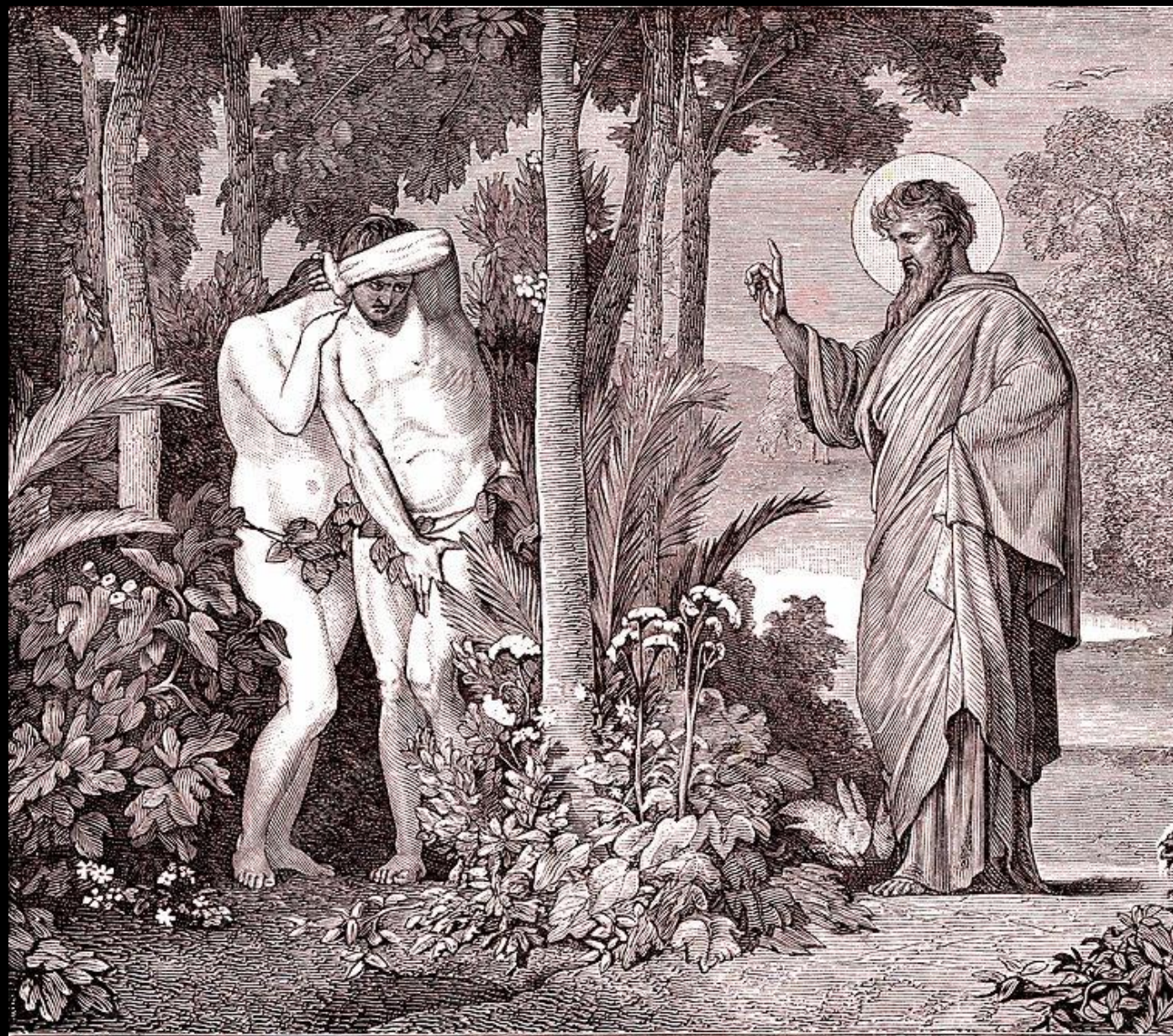

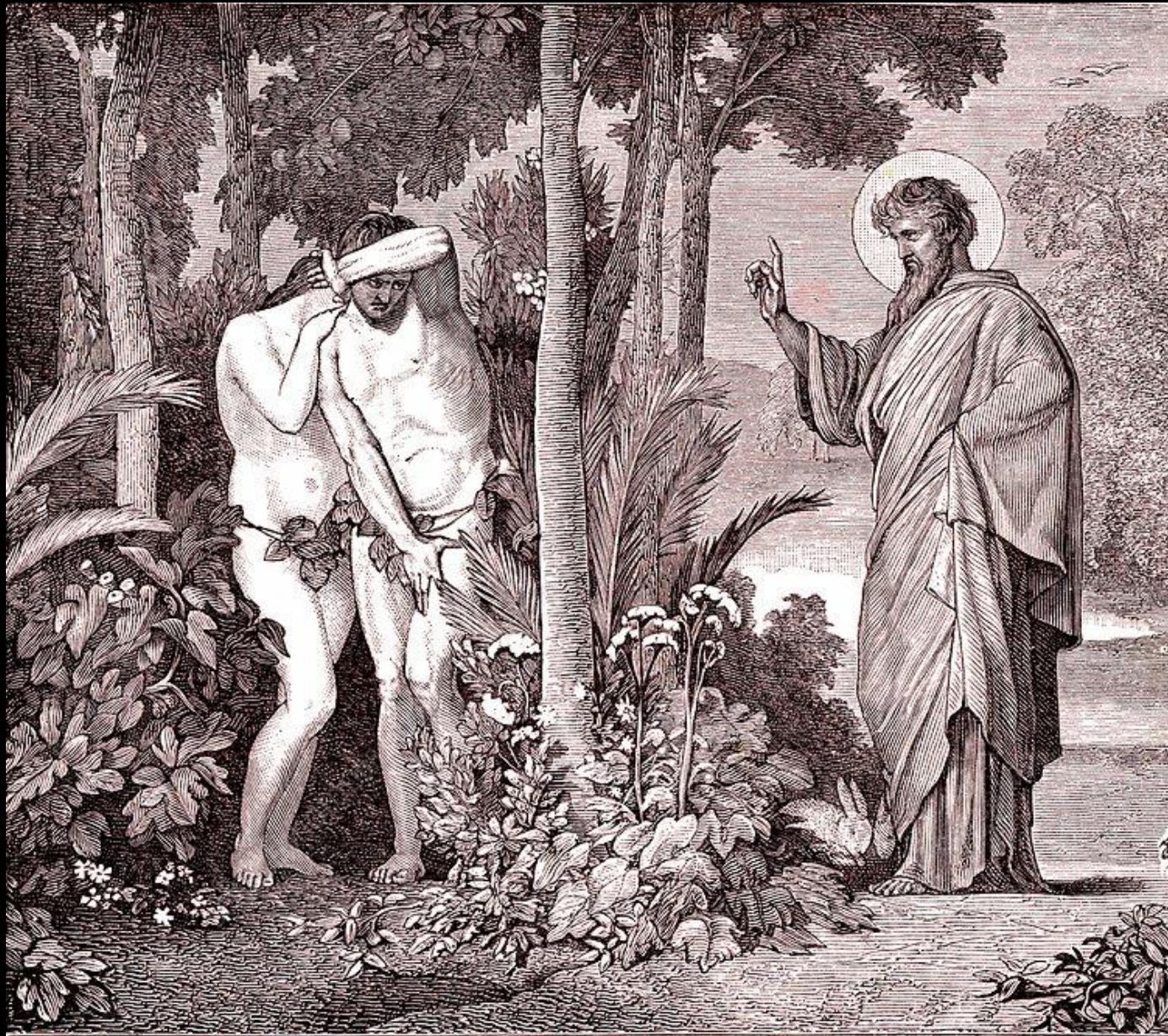

I've been adopted as God's child (Eph 1:5)

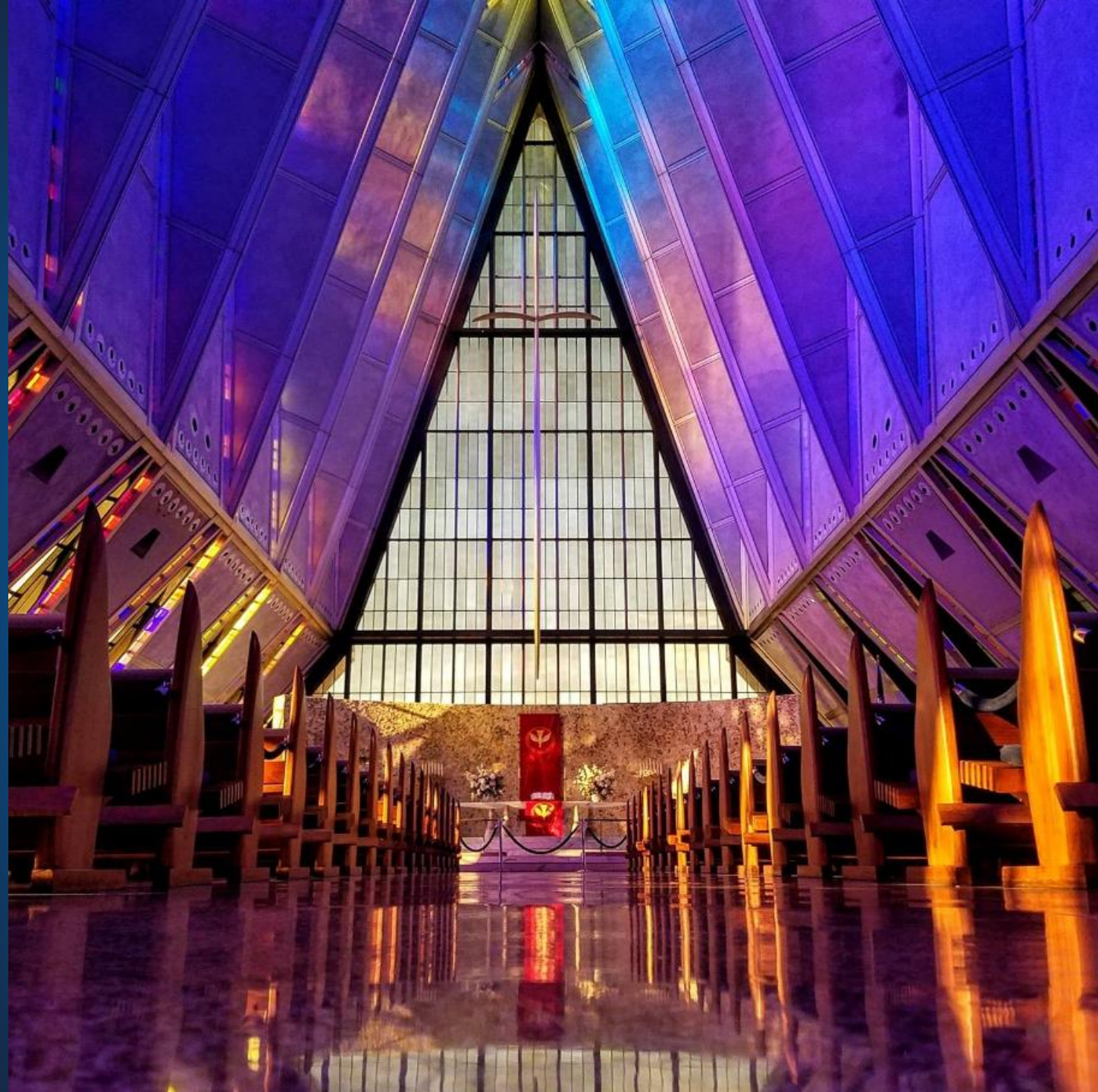
I am Christ's friend (John 15:15)
