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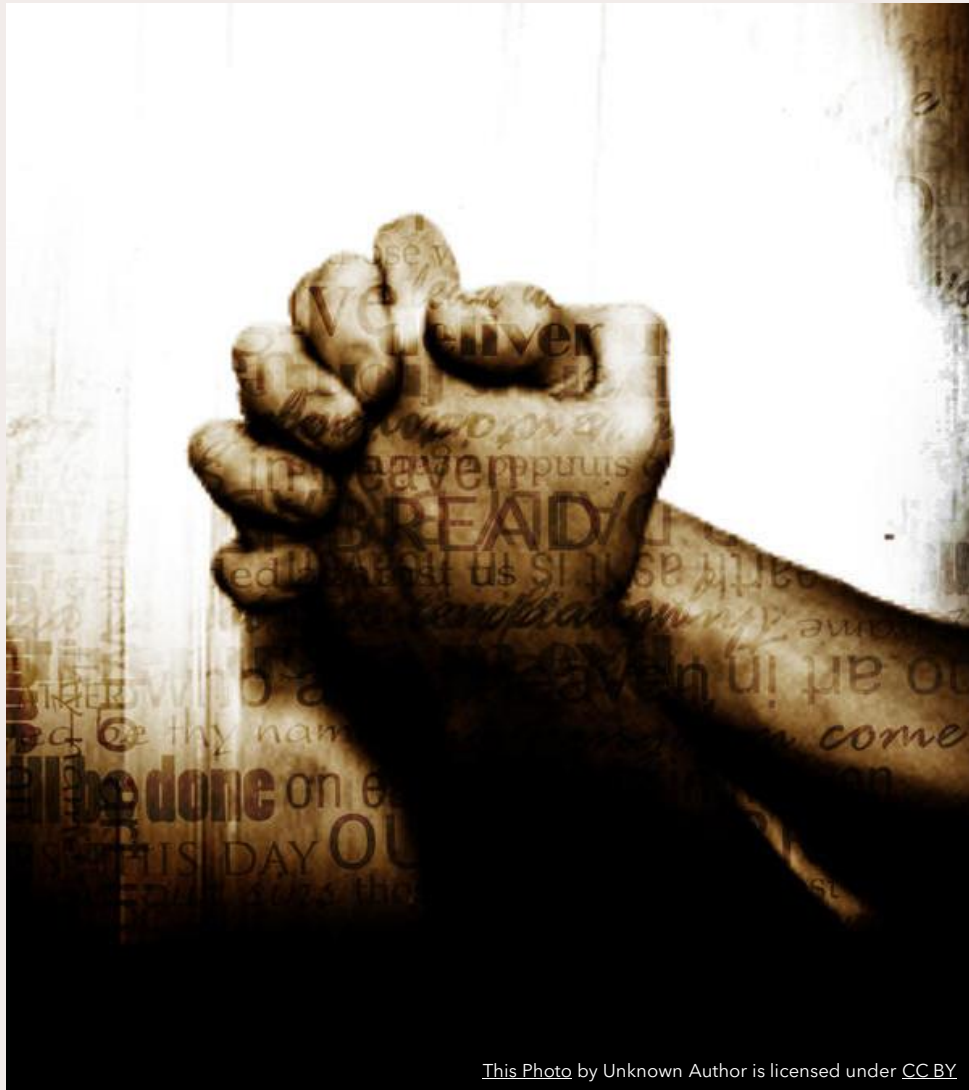

Chapter 6 Stand Firm!



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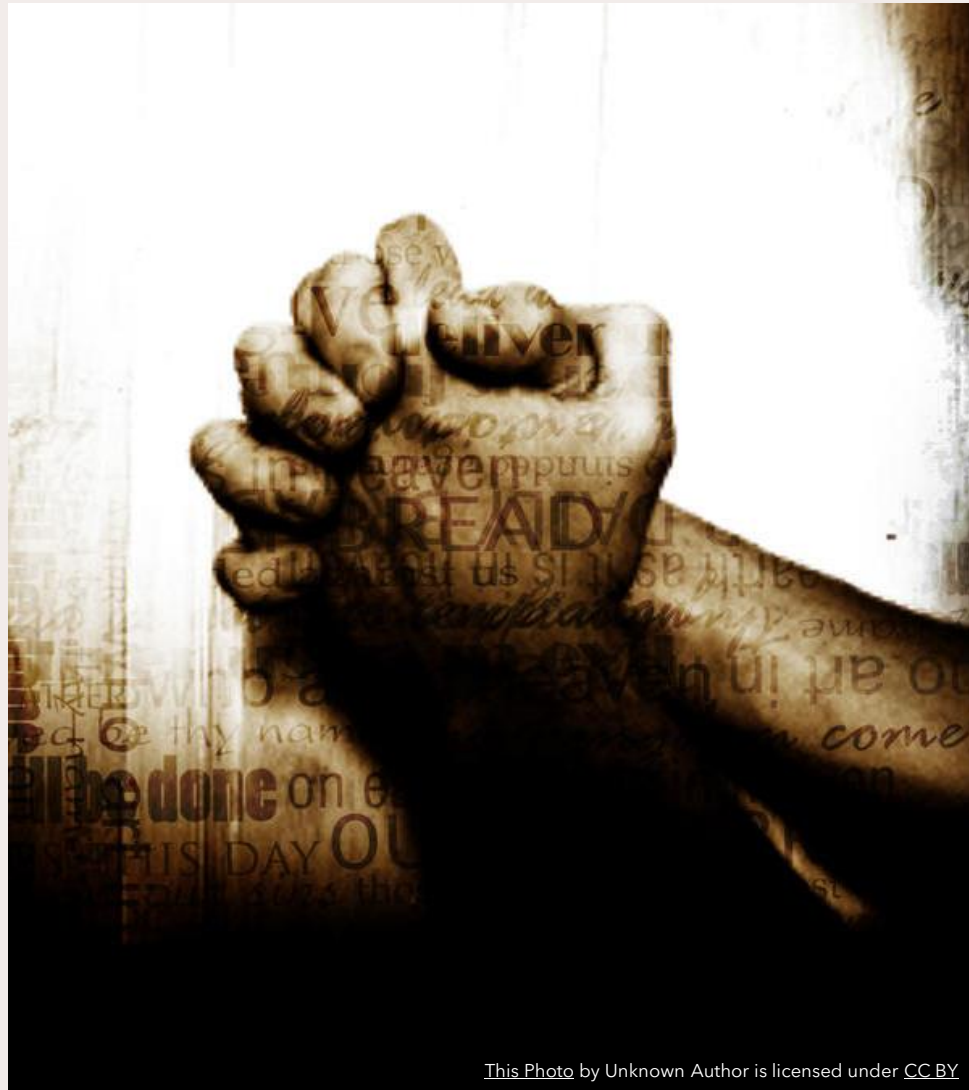

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IV. Working as Spirit-filled people in the Marketplace.

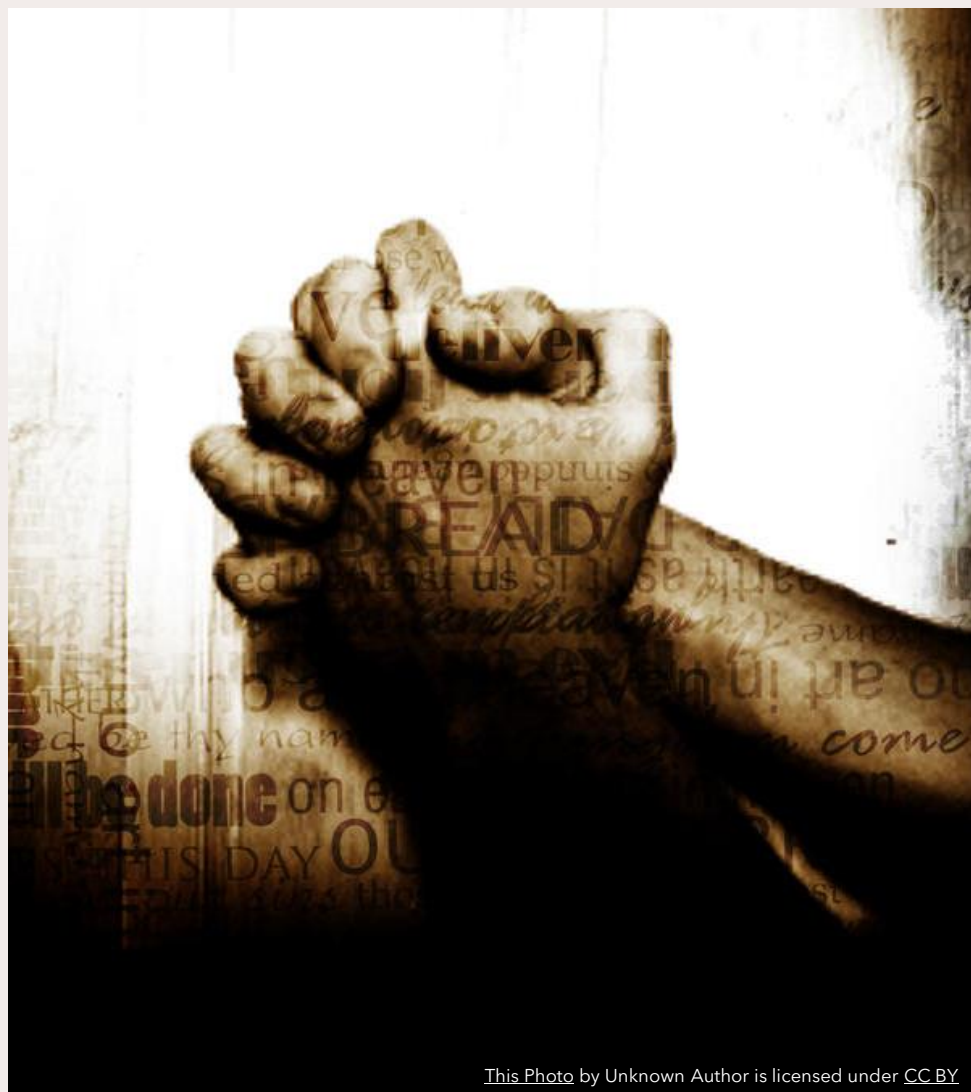
Ephesians 6:5-8 “Bondservants, obey your earthly masters with fear and trembling, with a sincere heart, as you would Christ, not by the way of eye-service, as people-pleasers, but as bondservants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart, rendering service with a good will as to the Lord and not to man, knowing that whatever good anyone does, this he will receive back from the Lord, whether he is a bondservant or is free.”



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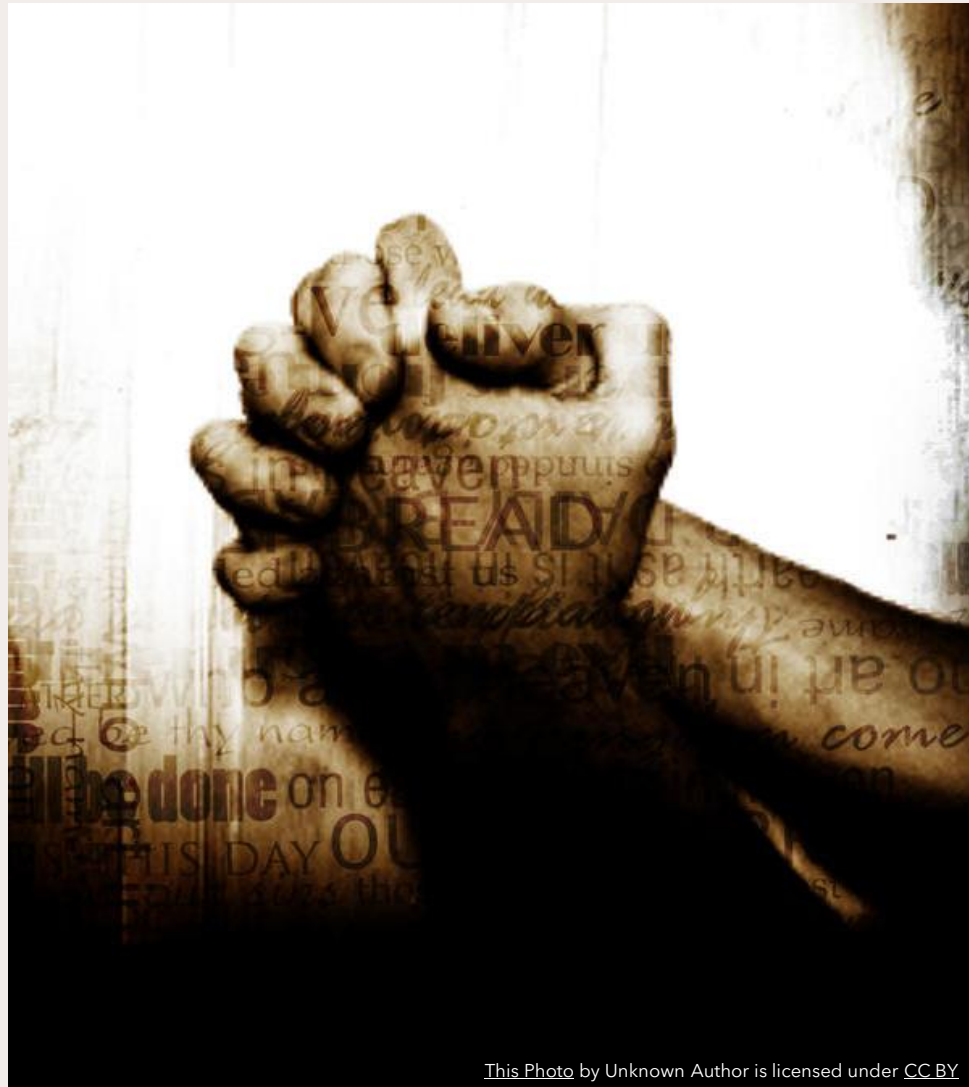
- The Greek word for “bondservants,” is “dulos.”
- Once again, “dulos,” is the Greek word for “slave.”



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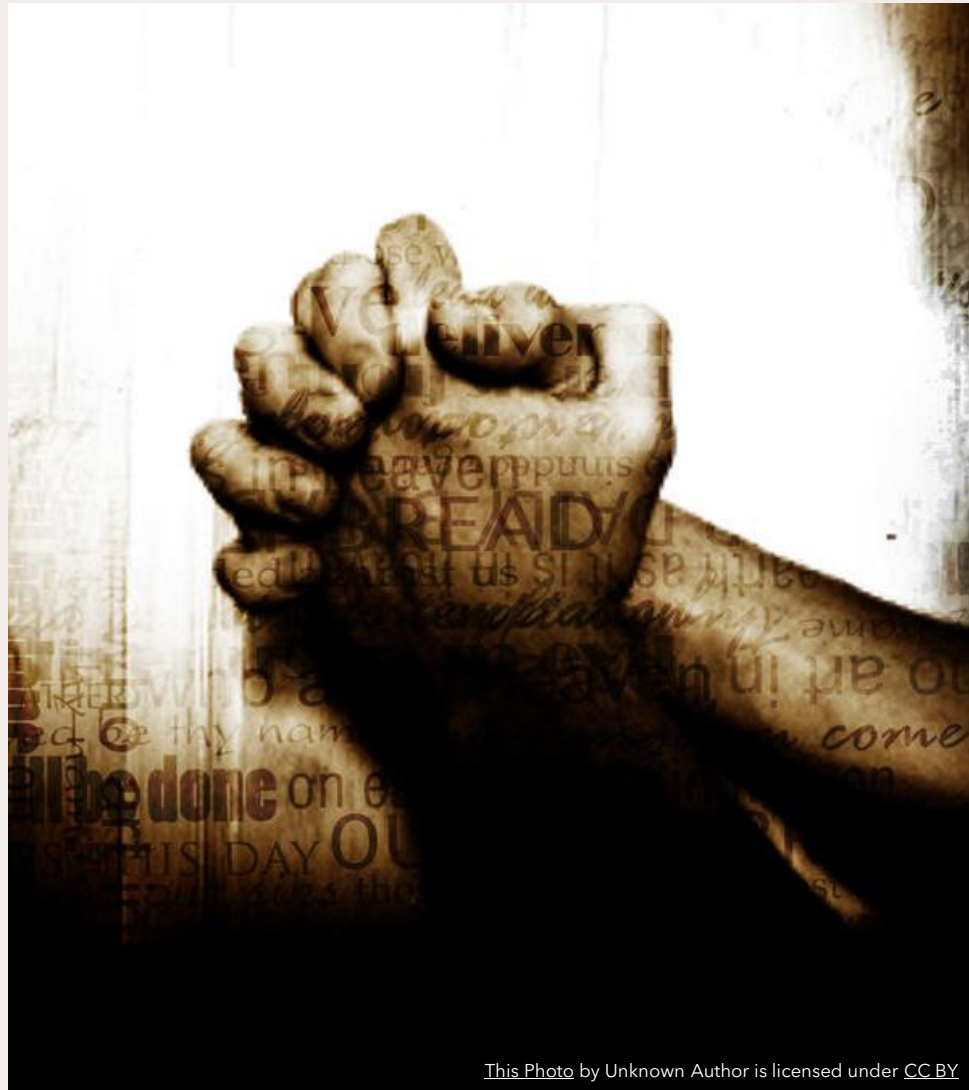
- I understand the cultural sensitivities involving this word.
- Even so, it is important that we put this in the context of our lesson today.
- Paul is addressing a culture where the owning of slaves was engaged in, even by middle-income people.



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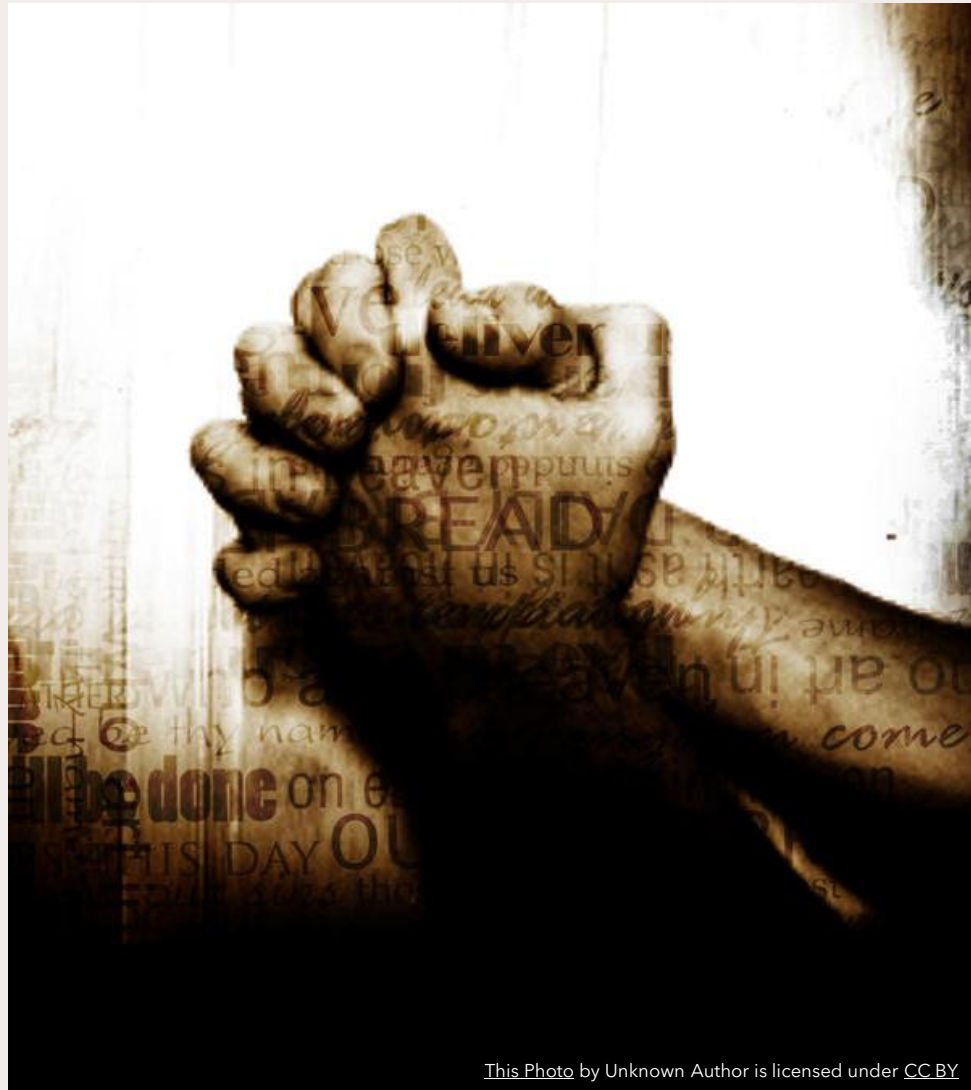
- Thankfully, we have ended the immoral and degrading practice of human beings owning human beings in this country.
- This, however, is not a practice ended the world over.
- What is more, there are NO people groups that have not been enslaved at some point in their history.



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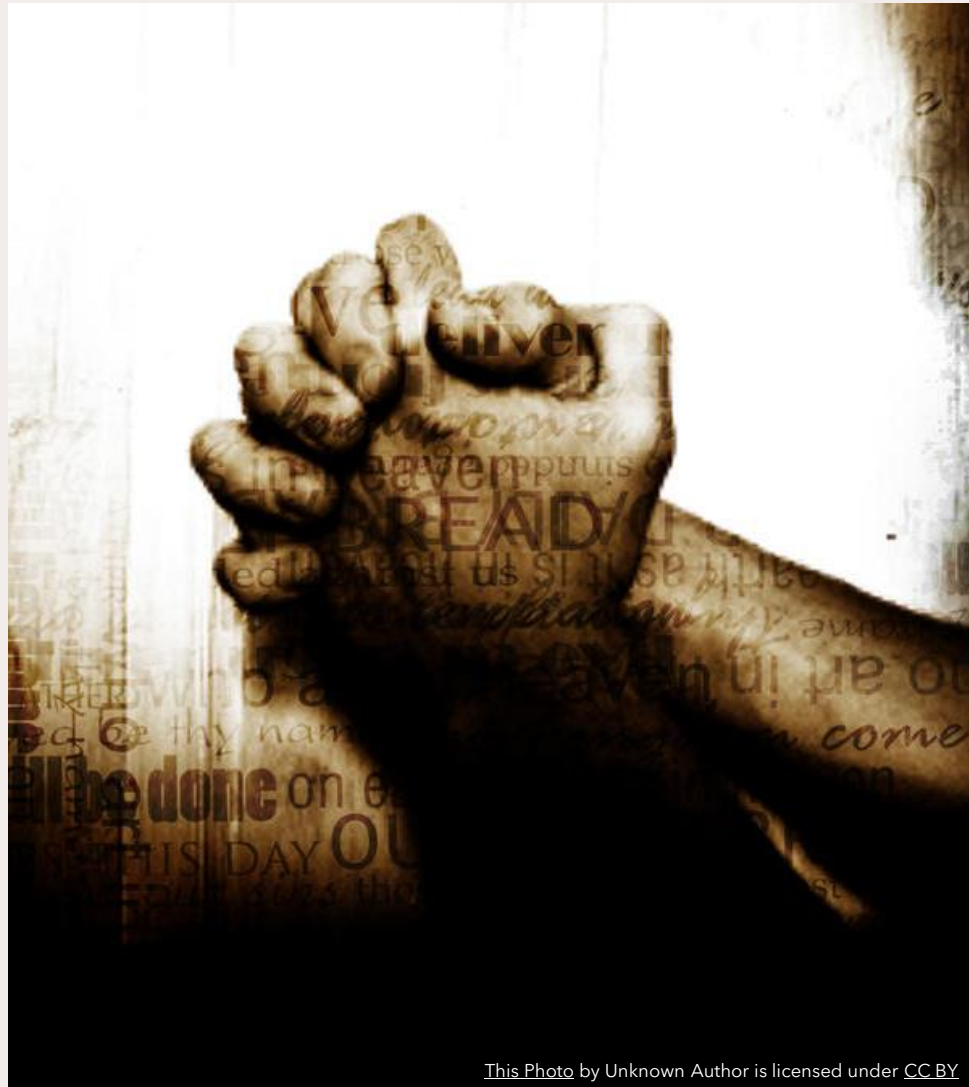
- A conquered people being taken into slavery was a very common practice.
- Even the Chosen People where enslaved for almost 400 years by the Egyptians.



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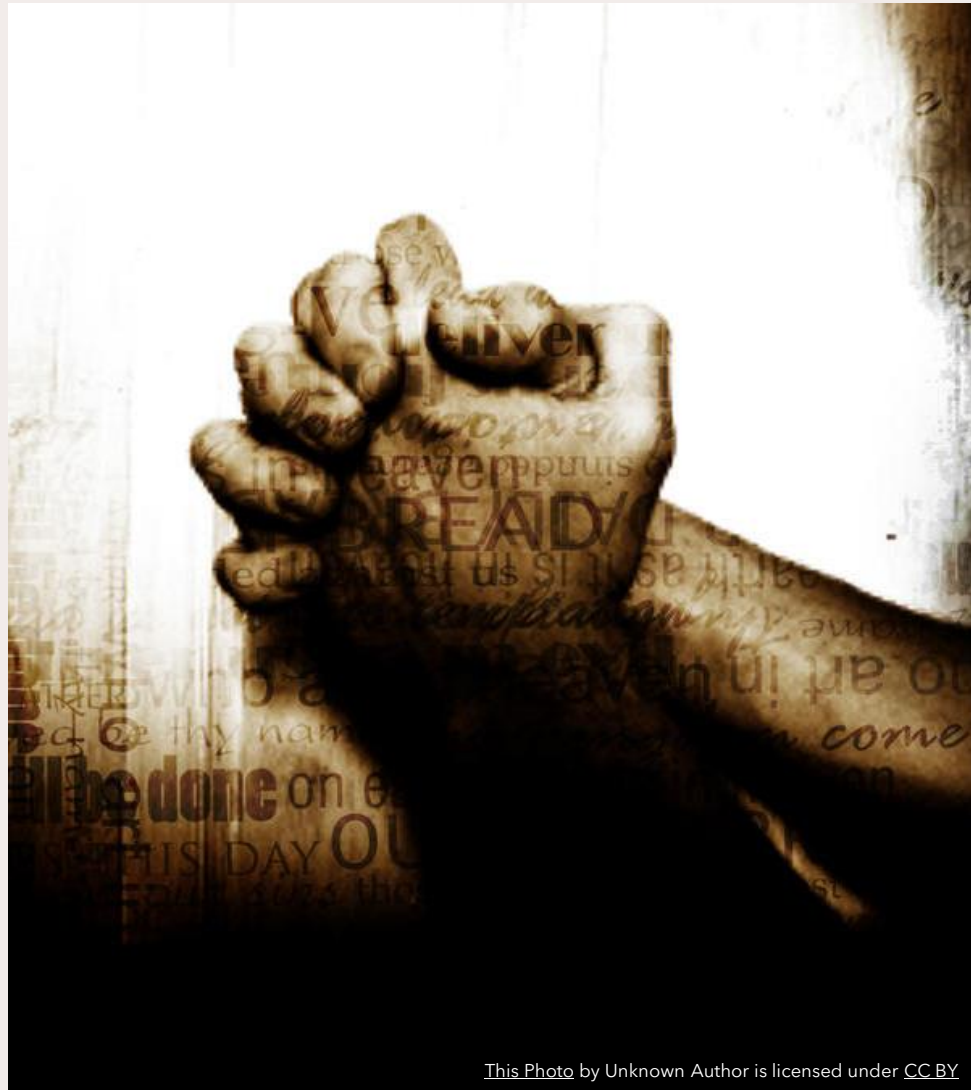
- Why am I spending so much time with this? I am spending time with it because I believe the Bible gets a bad rap, in terms of the promotion of slavery.
- Yes, there are verses that cannot be interpreted as anything but pro-slavery, unless the New Testament is taken in proper context.



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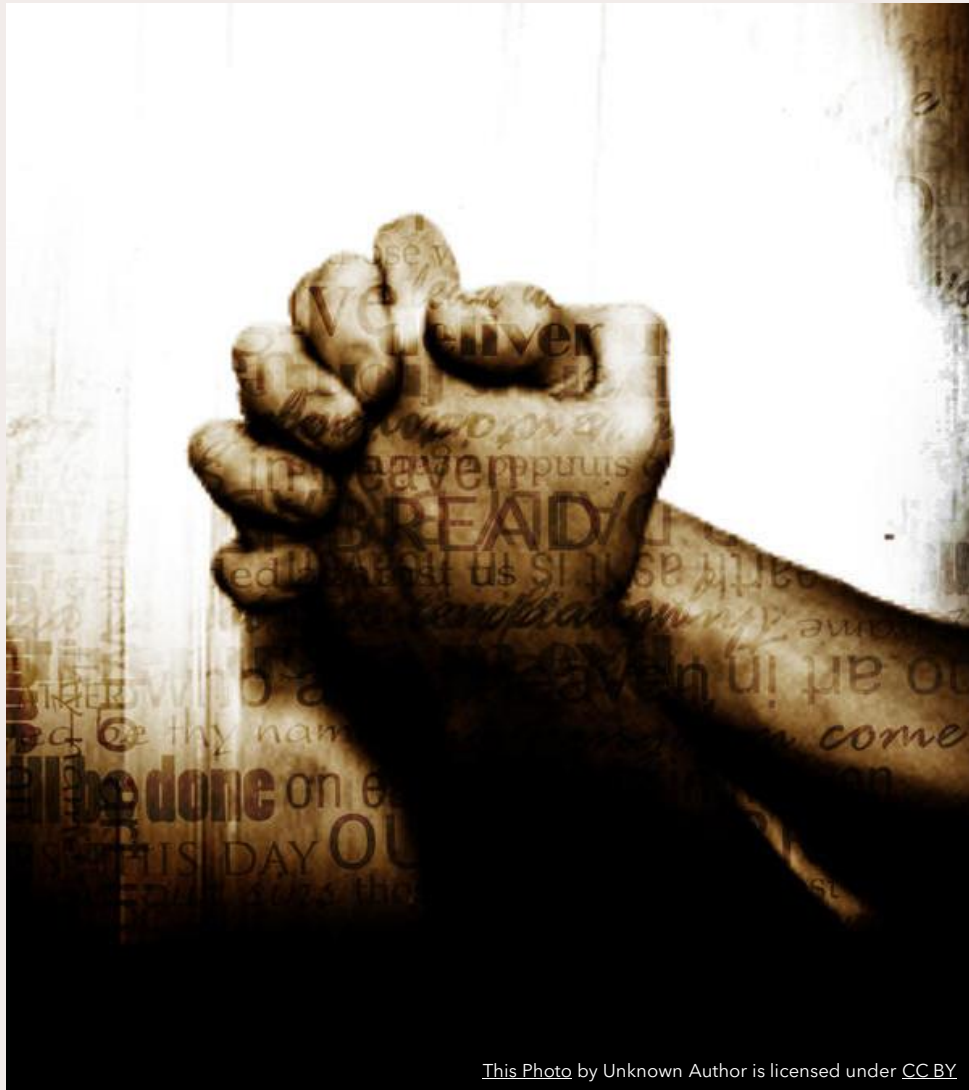
- Letters like Philemon, for example, seek the release of a slave called Onesimus because not only is his owner a Christian, but so too has Onesimus become a believer.
- If Philemon is unwilling to release him, Paul offers to buy the freedom of Onesimus.
- Additionally, passages like Jeremiah 22:13 and 34:9-10, and Matthew 23:10, and 1 Corinthians 7:21 all condemn slavery.



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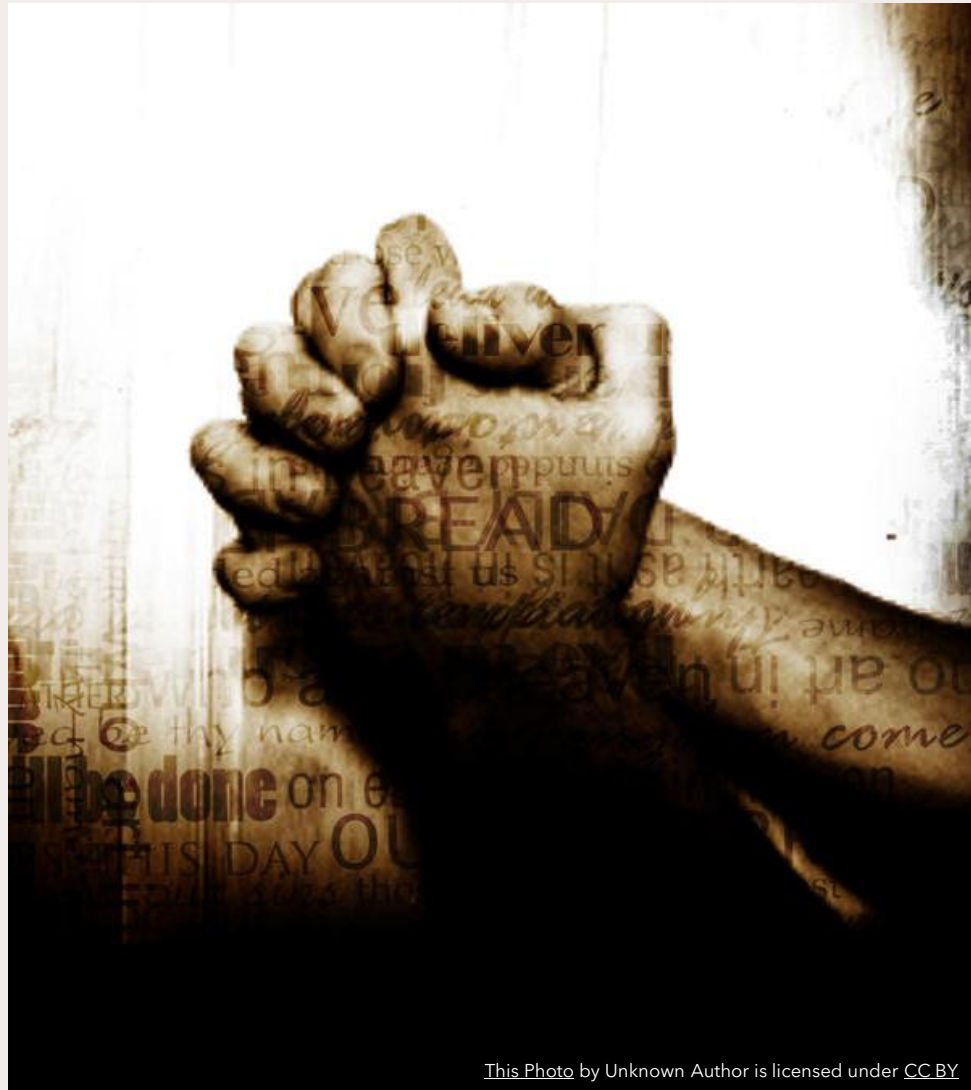
- Paul's focus was not on the worldly conditions in which believers occupied.
- Instead, he lived as if the return of Jesus was imminent.
- Therefore, his council was to remain wherever you are and live out the Gospel in the hopes of introducing and even bringing your master to faith.



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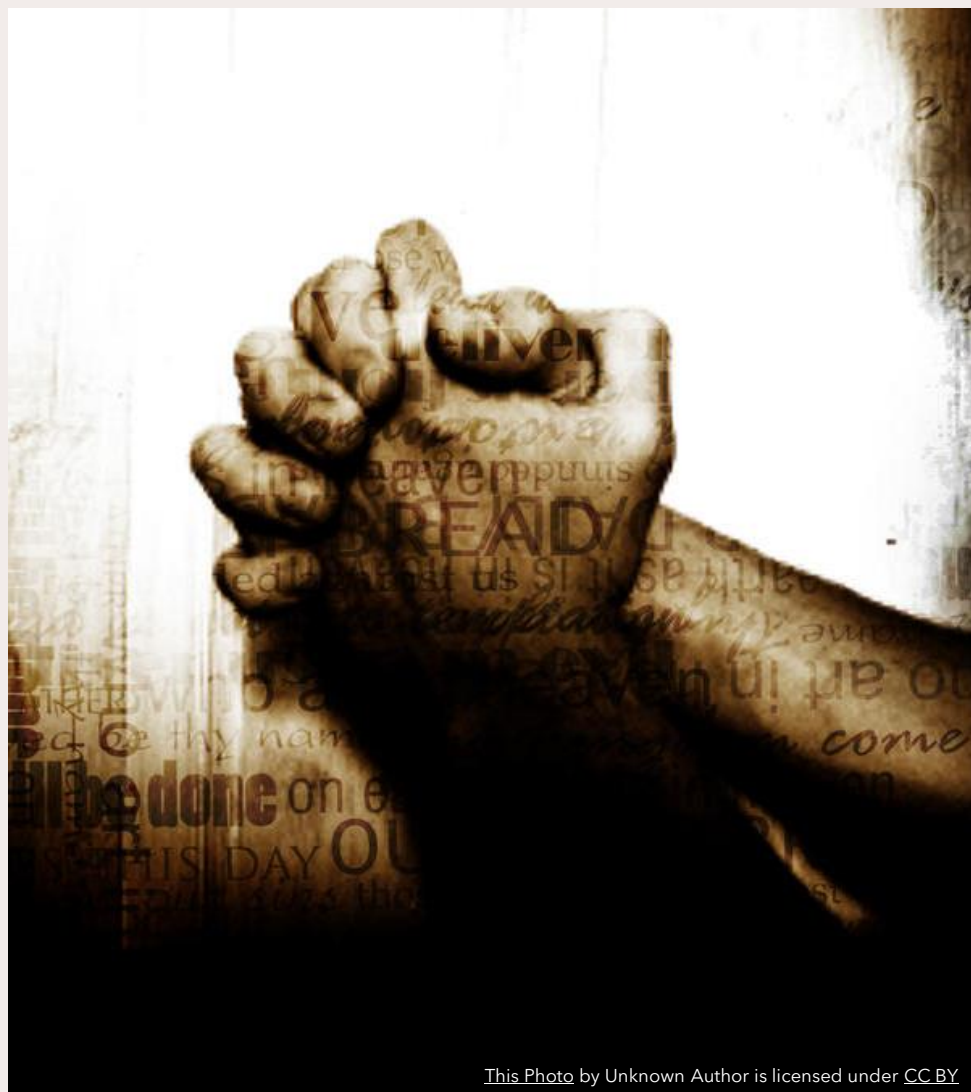

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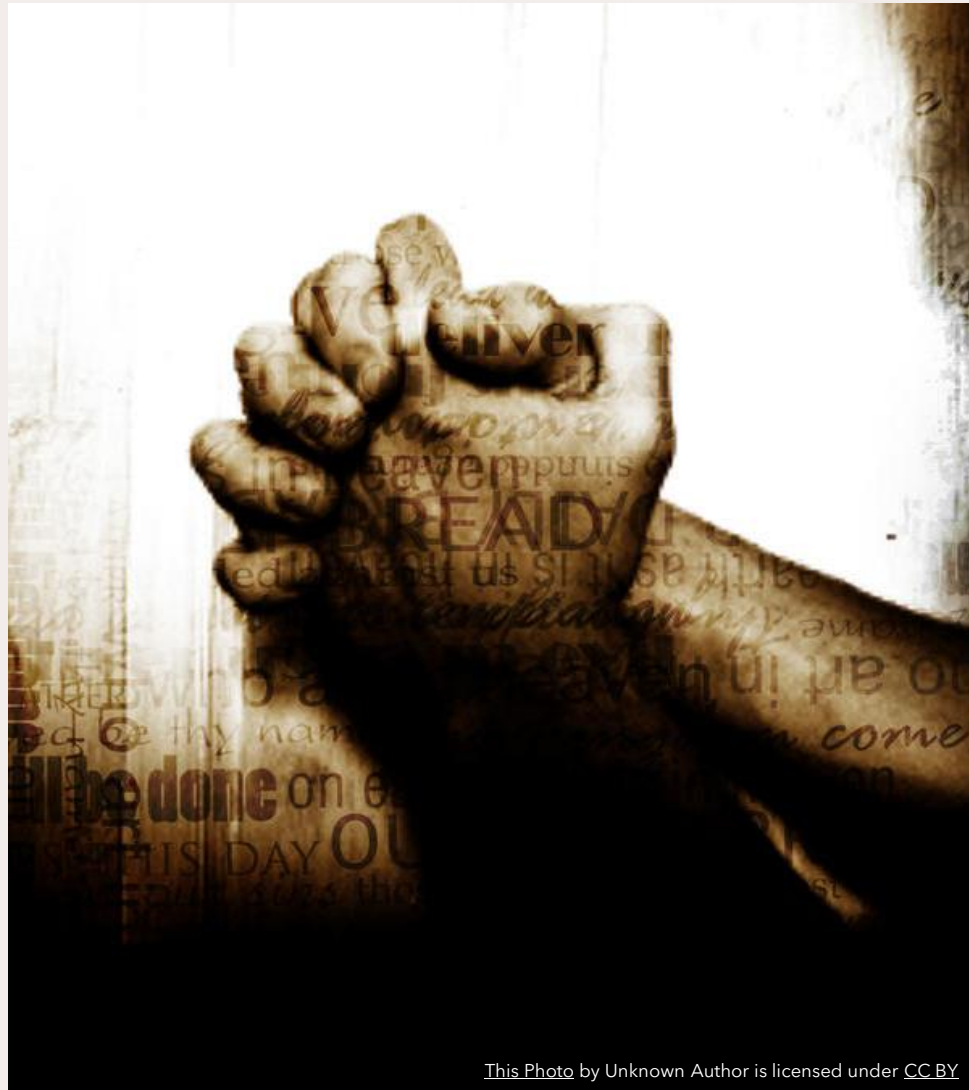

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- Paul is NOT promoting or sanctioning slavery, he is speaking to believers, advising them NOT to focus on their circumstances.
- In other words, the mission is the same wherever you find yourself.



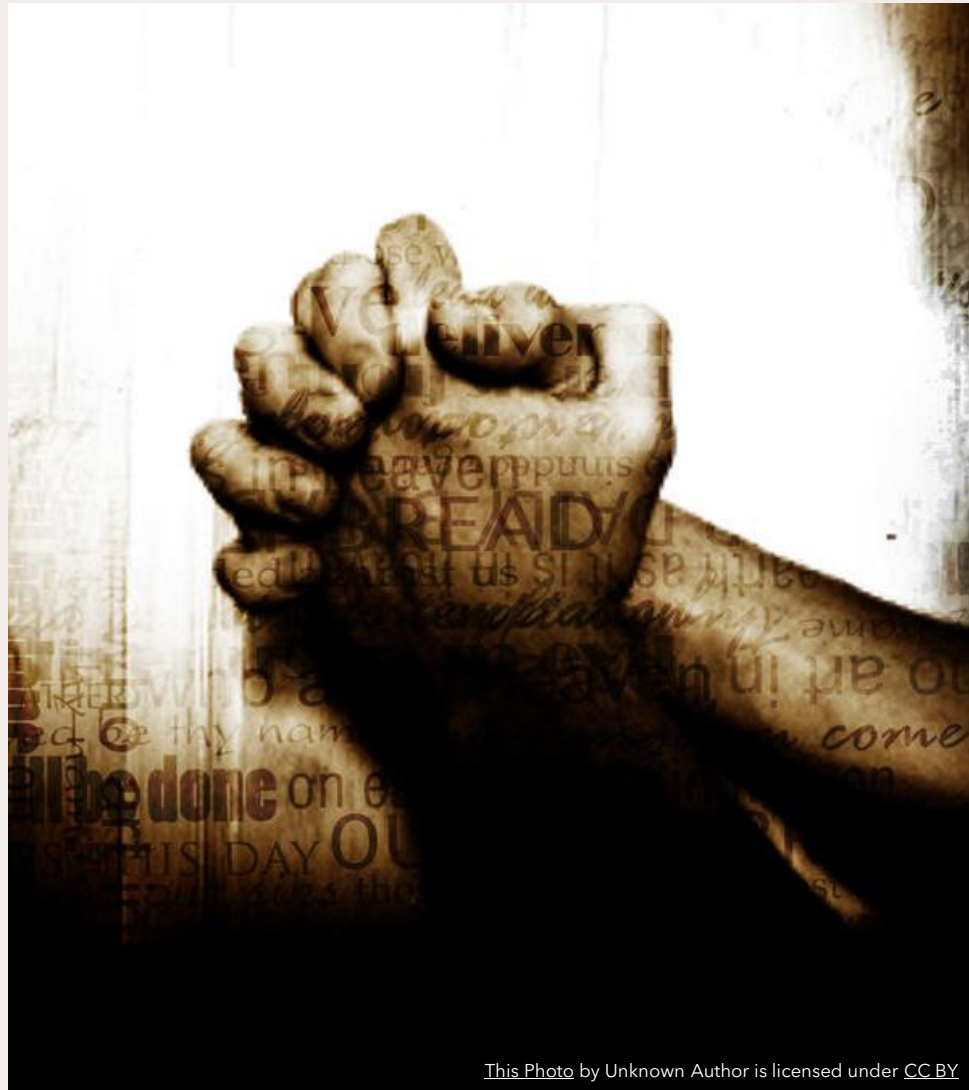
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■ Summary

➤ TO WORKERS (VV5-8):

- 1) We are to work with integrity whether someone is closely supervising us or not.
- 2) When you work, why are you doing what you do? Are you just punching a clock for money, or just doing your work to please another human being? Or, are you doing your work to please the Lord, as if to the Lord.



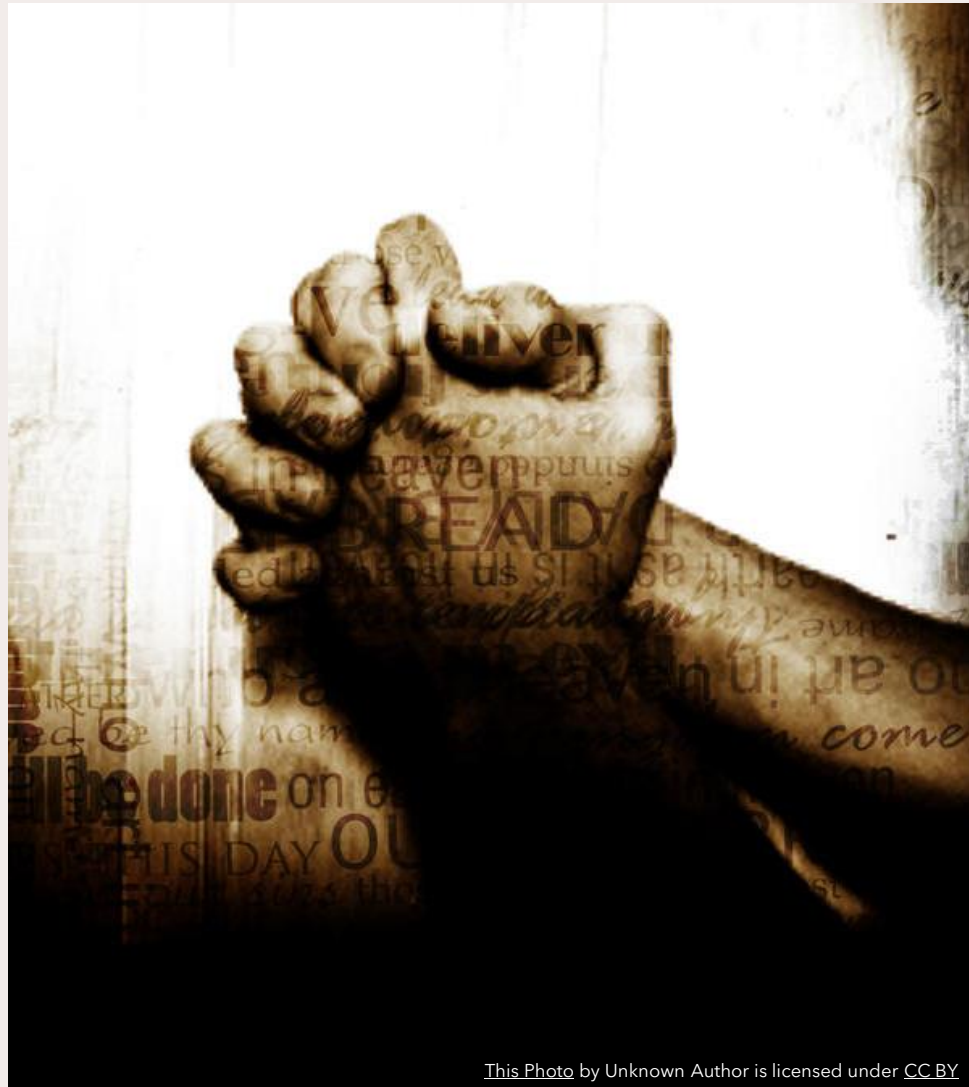
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■ Summary

Whatever you do, do it as if to an audience of One, because as workers, you will be held accountable for the way you worked.



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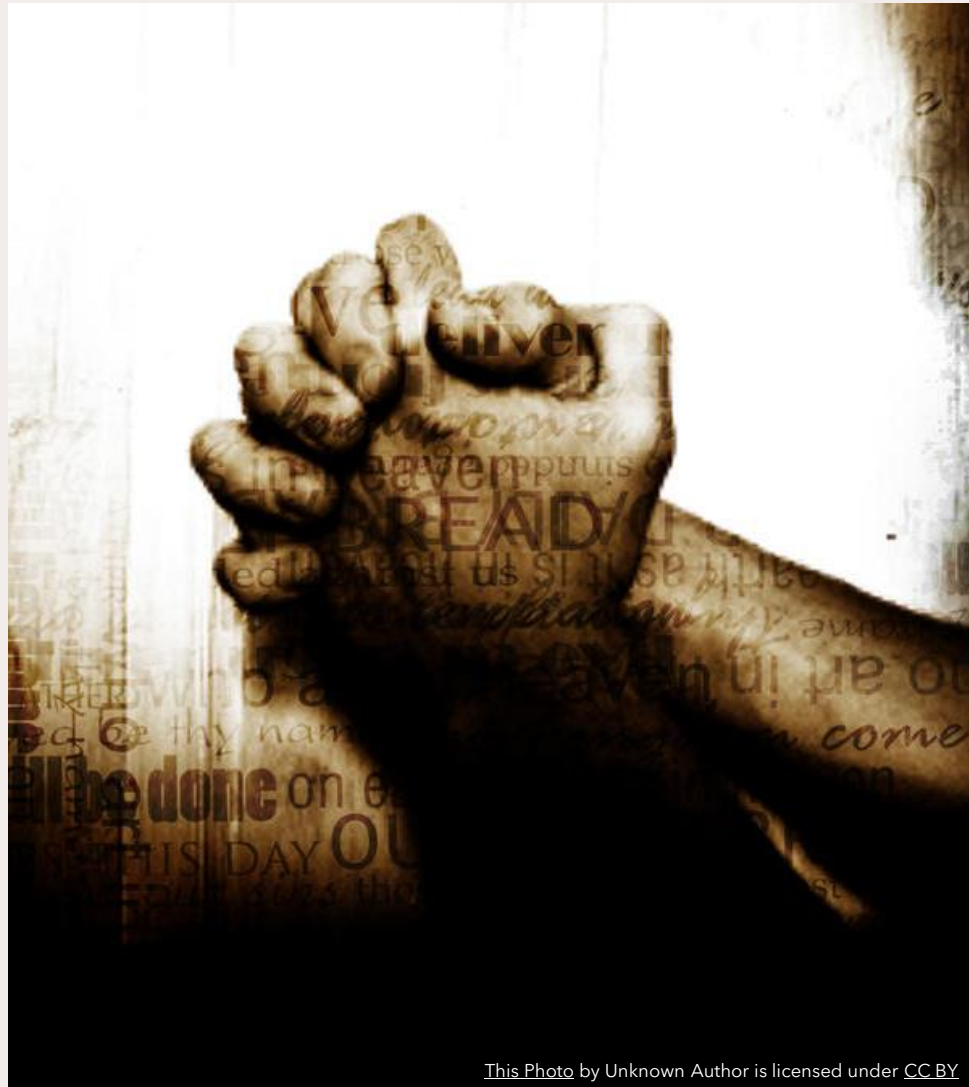
IV. Working as Spirit-filled people in the Marketplace.

■ Summary

➤ TO THE EMPLOYER:

1) You are to treat your workers the way you would want to be treated. In other words, treat them as if Christ is watching you...because He is!

2) WARNING! You may be the big boss here, but there is ONE BIG MASTER in Heaven. Know that with Him, there is no favoritism. You and your employees will stand on equal ground before Father God.

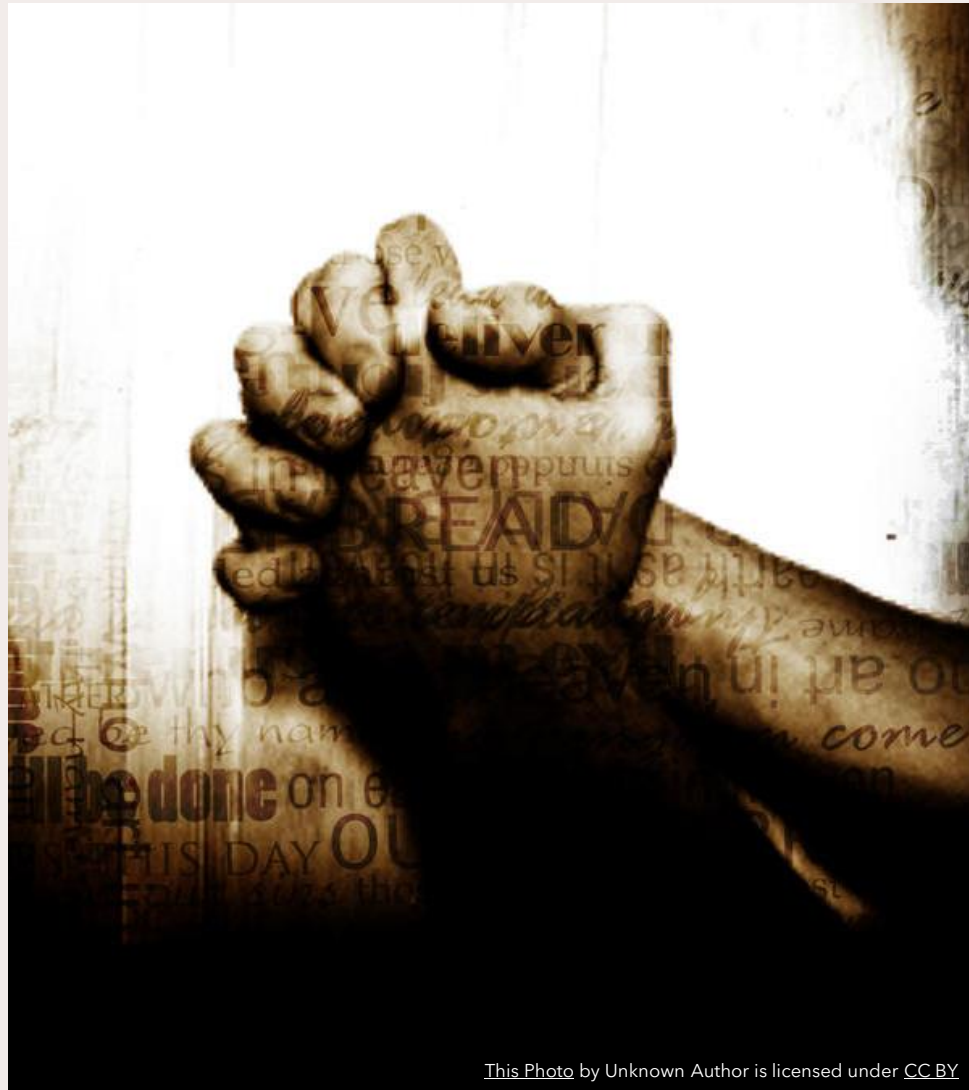
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- At the very moment when Jesus, on the cross, gave up His spirit and cried out, “It is finished,” Satan and his demonic host knew the rebellion had failed miserably.

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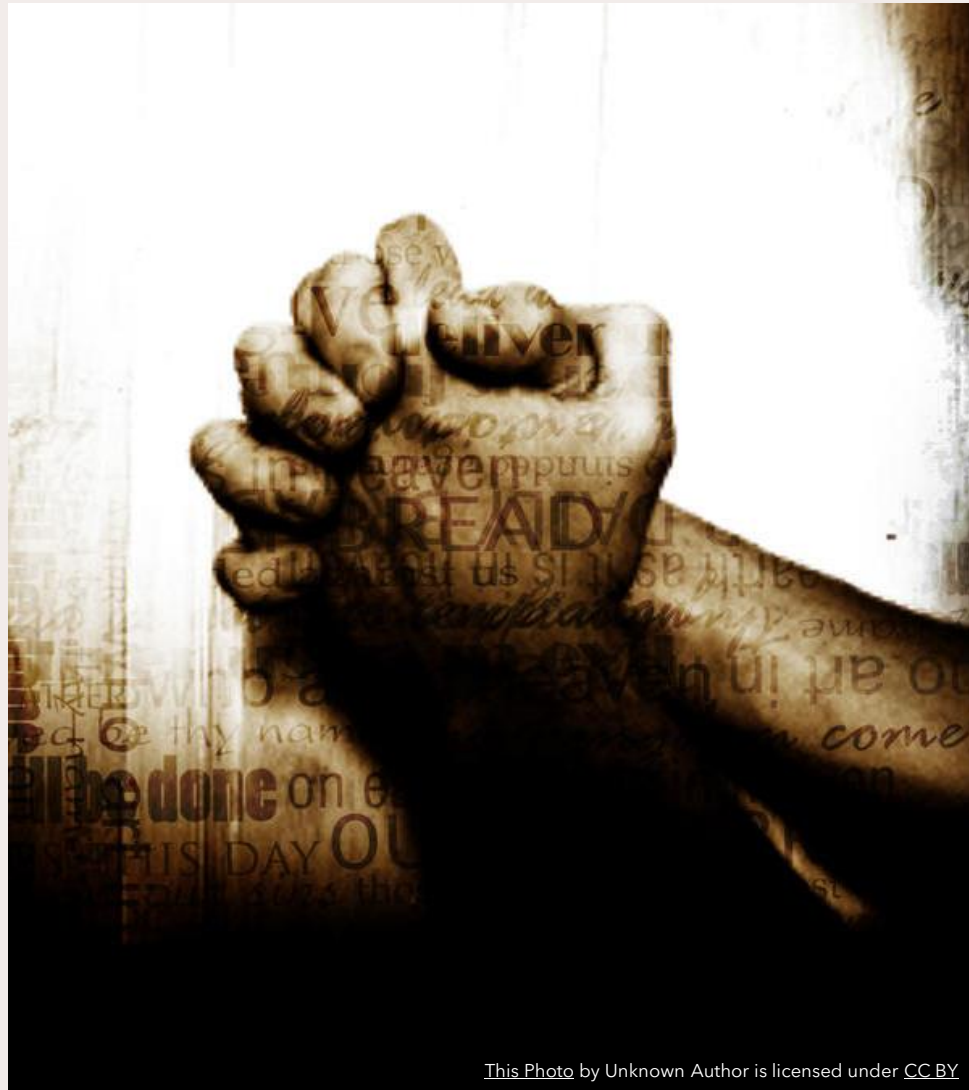
- For those however, who have opened their eyes to the meaning of the cross, the war is OVER between Father God and humanity. Our sin issue is satisfied.
- Jesus has ensured it, and the Holy Spirit, as we heard in Ephesians 1:14, has guaranteed it.



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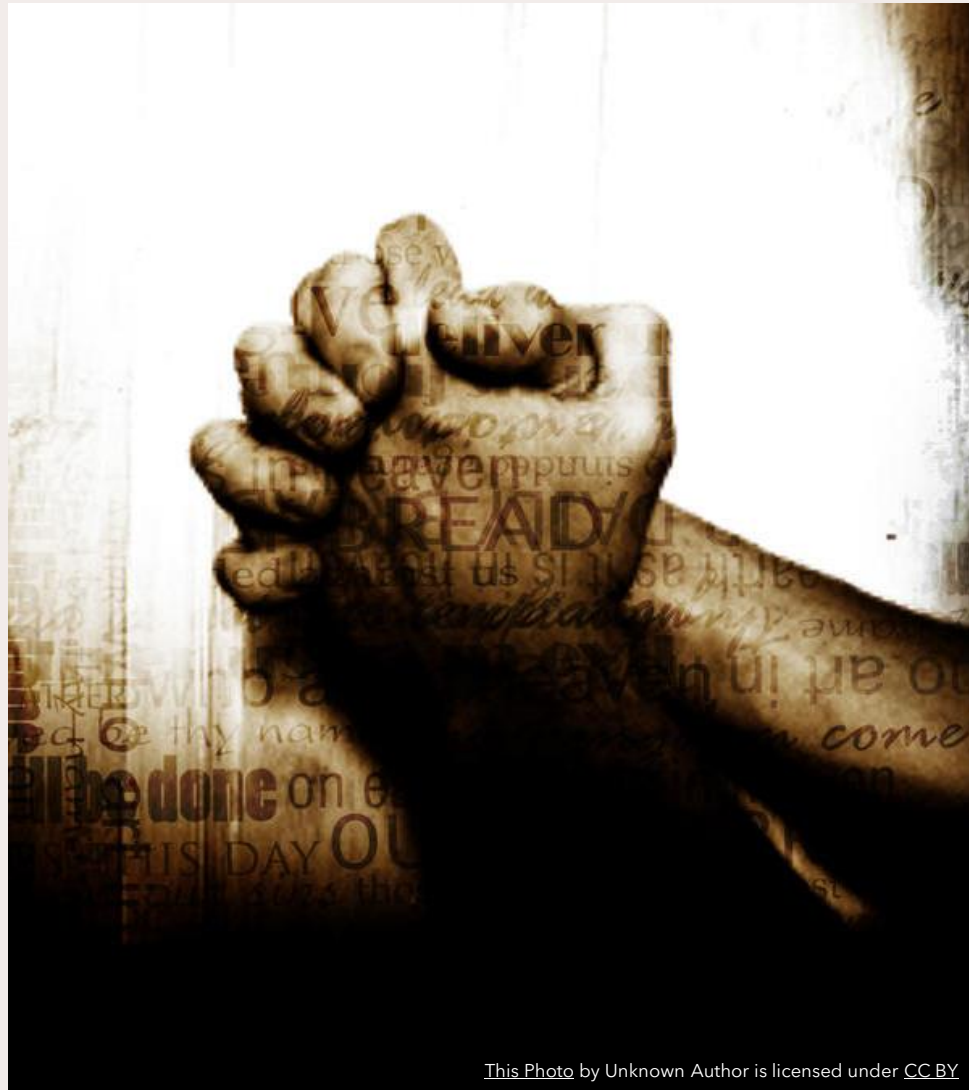
- The mission of Jesus, and therefore our mission, is NOT to judge, but to bring people to the saving knowledge of salvation.

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- The war may be over between Father God and humanity, but the war CONTINUES between humanity and the demonic hosts.



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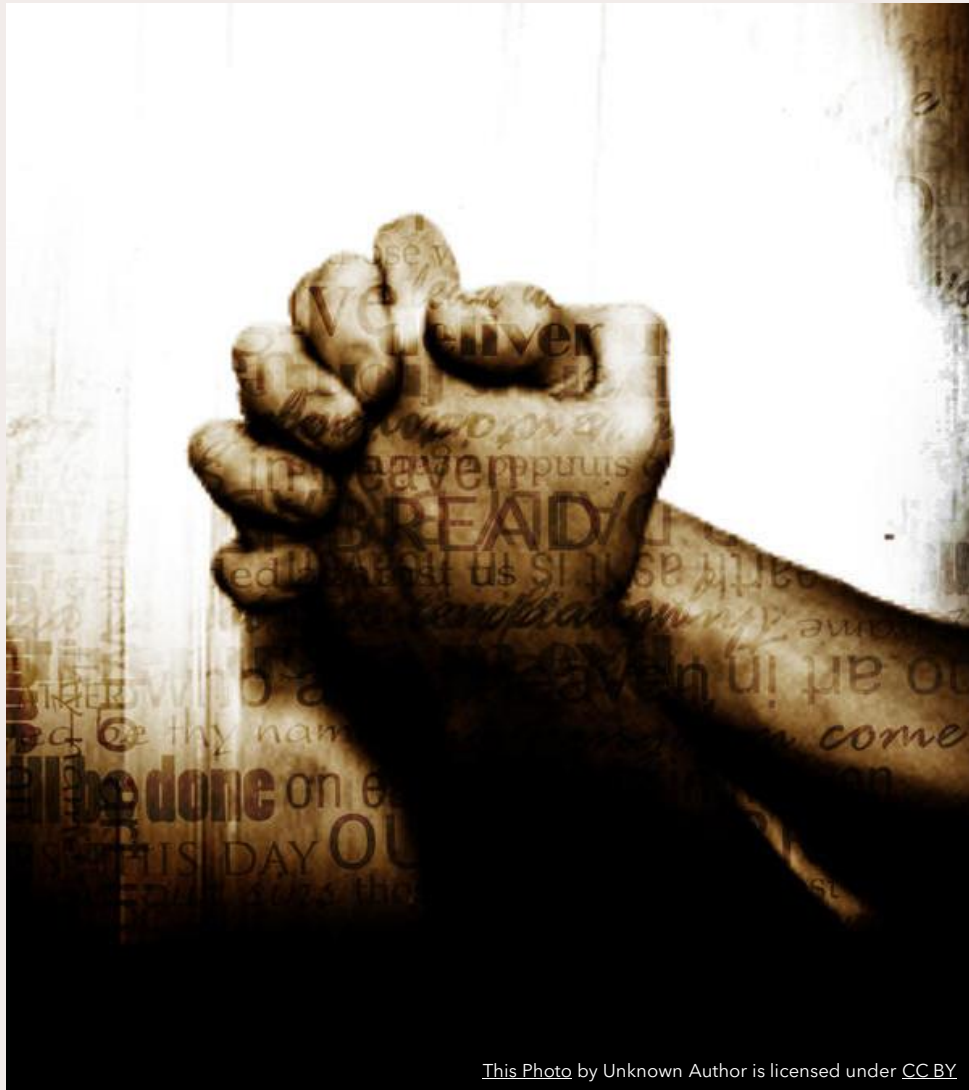

- Therefore, by tapping into it, you will be fully ready with all the strength you need.



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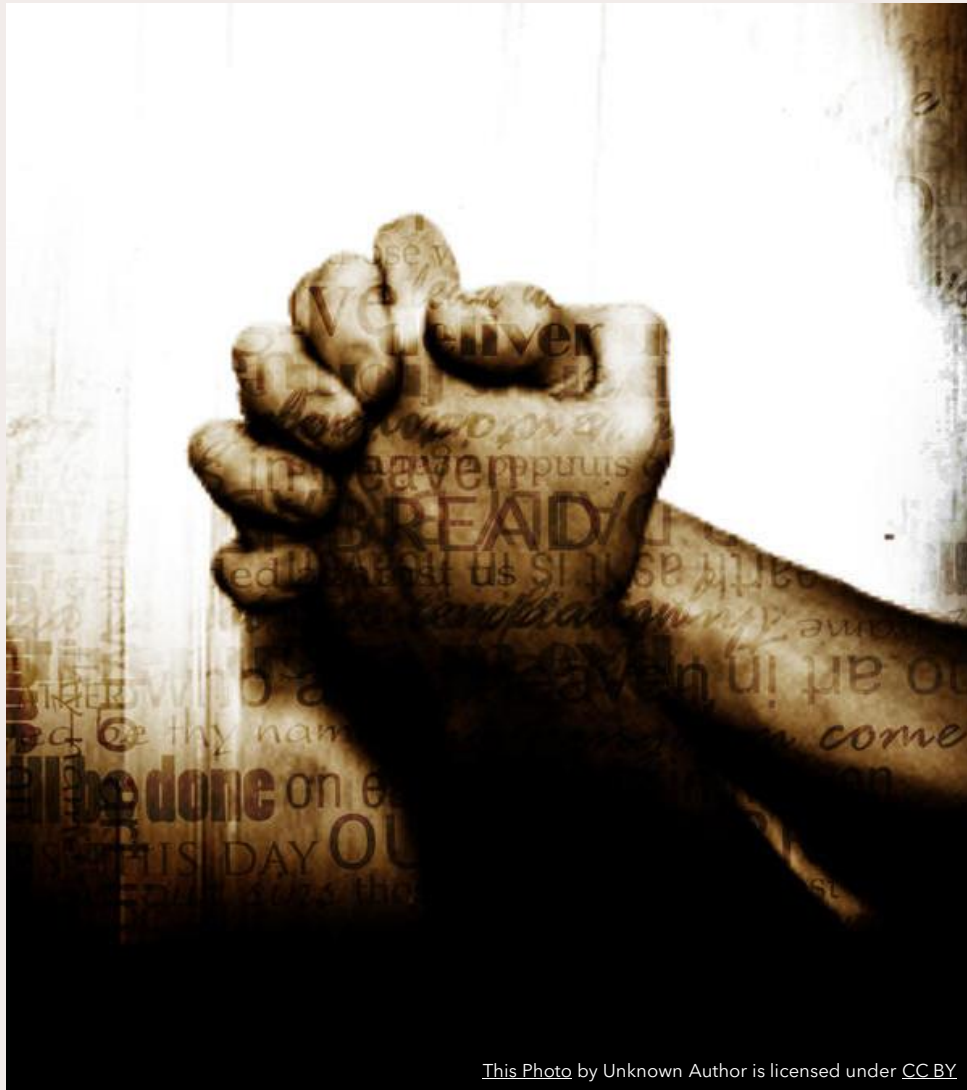

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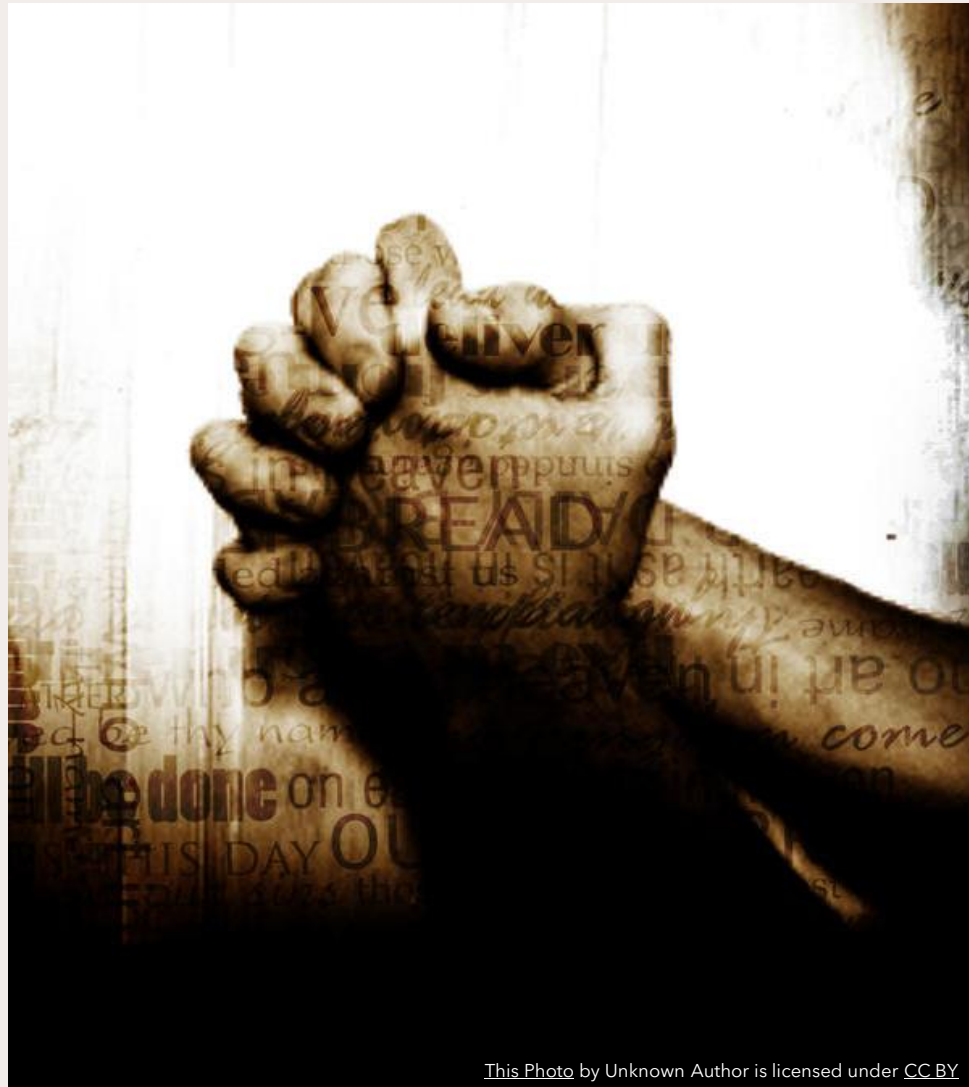
- This theme of strength and courage is found strongly throughout the Scriptures.

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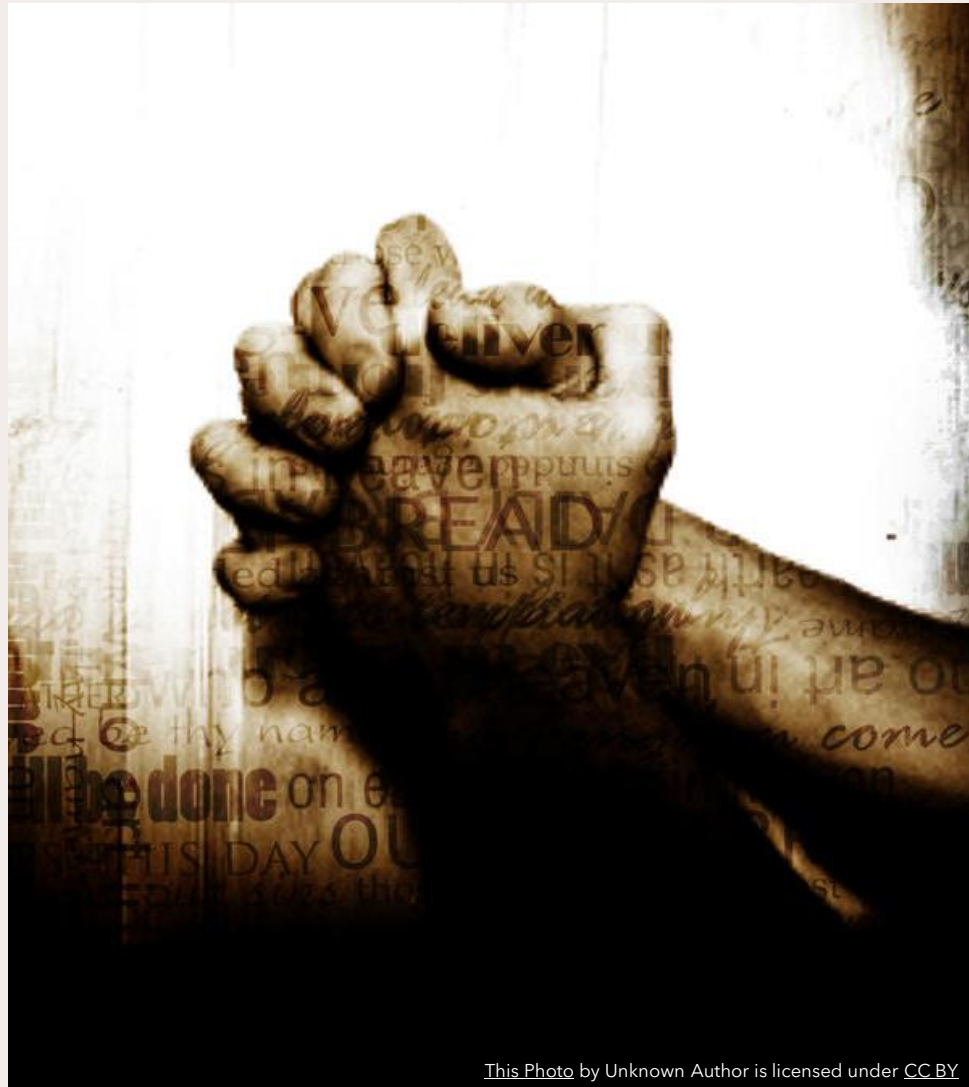
- When things seem dark, you have entered into a territory where the schemes and cleverness and deceit of the devil, and those he has influenced, has taken dominance in the atmosphere.

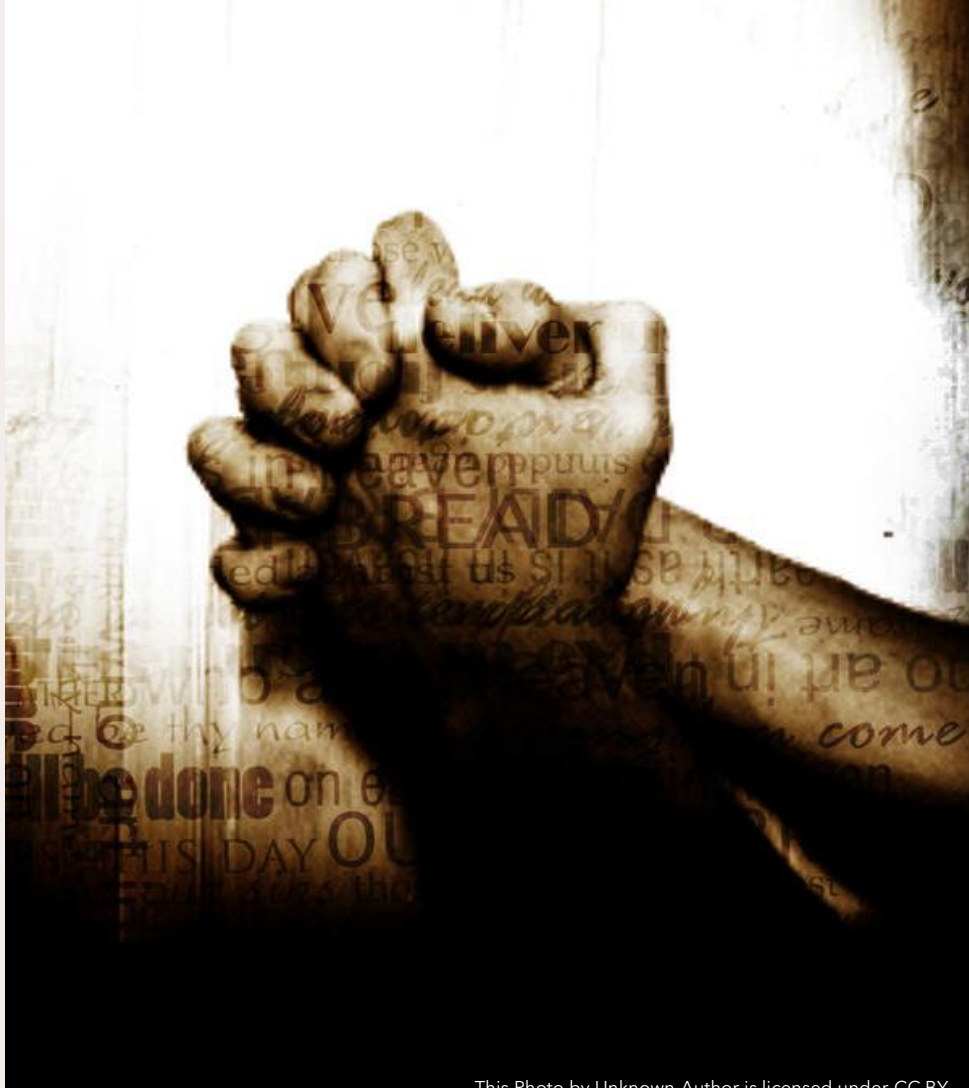


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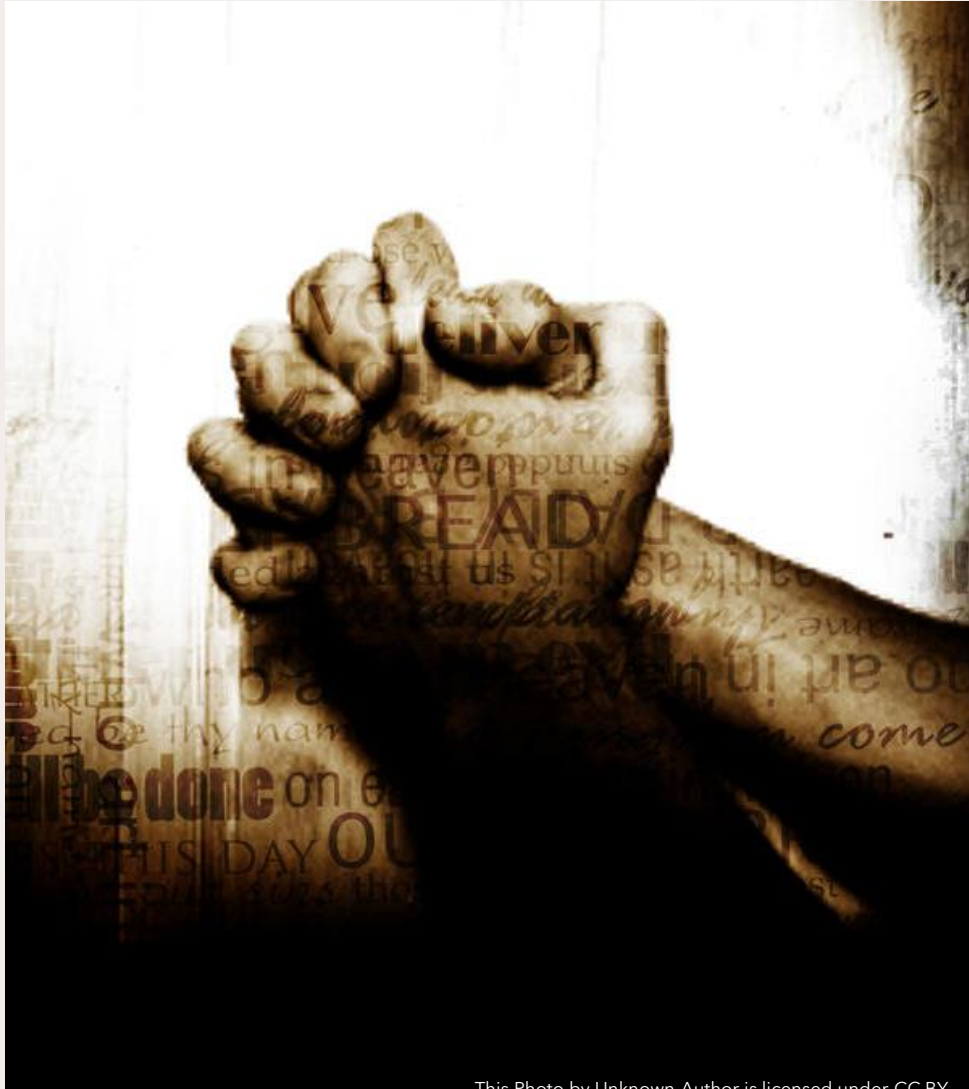
- “Therefore, knowing what we now know about our target and our objective, and knowing that we still reside in enemy territory, we need to be fully prepared to take our stand.”



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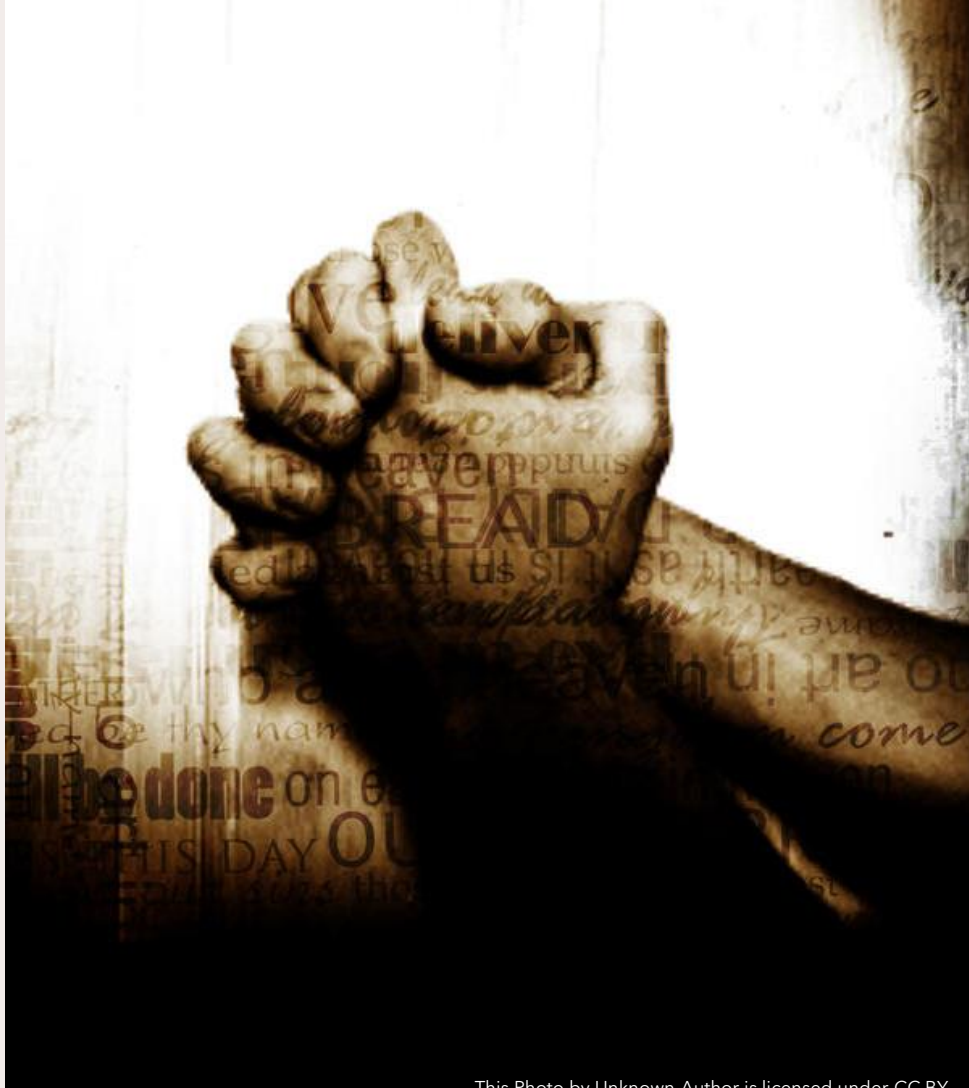
- Paul says, “*that you may be able to withstand the evil day...*” What does that mean?
- Their objective is to take you down. But if that does not happen, they at least want to slow you down.



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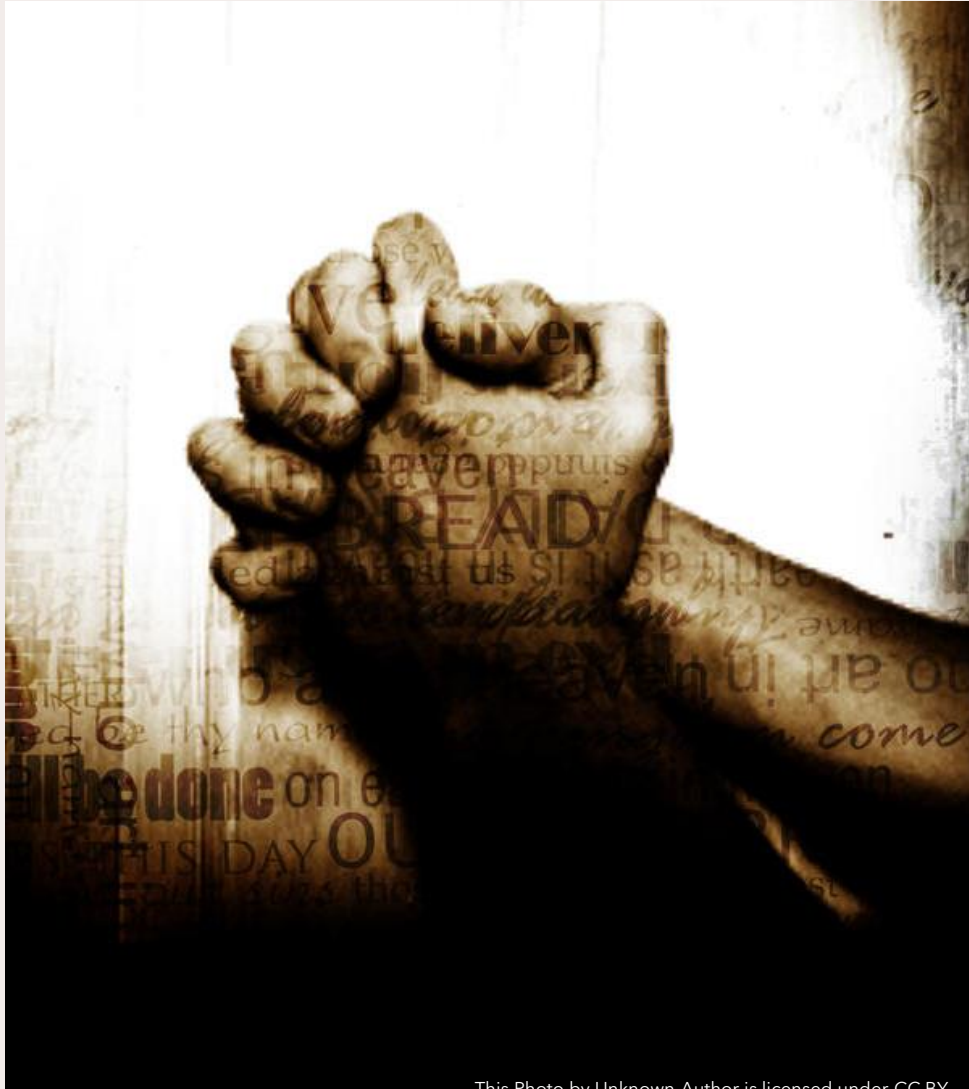
- Paul says, “*that you may be able to withstand the evil day...*” What does that mean?
- Taking you down involves what Paul said earlier, i.e., introducing impurities, Eph 5.

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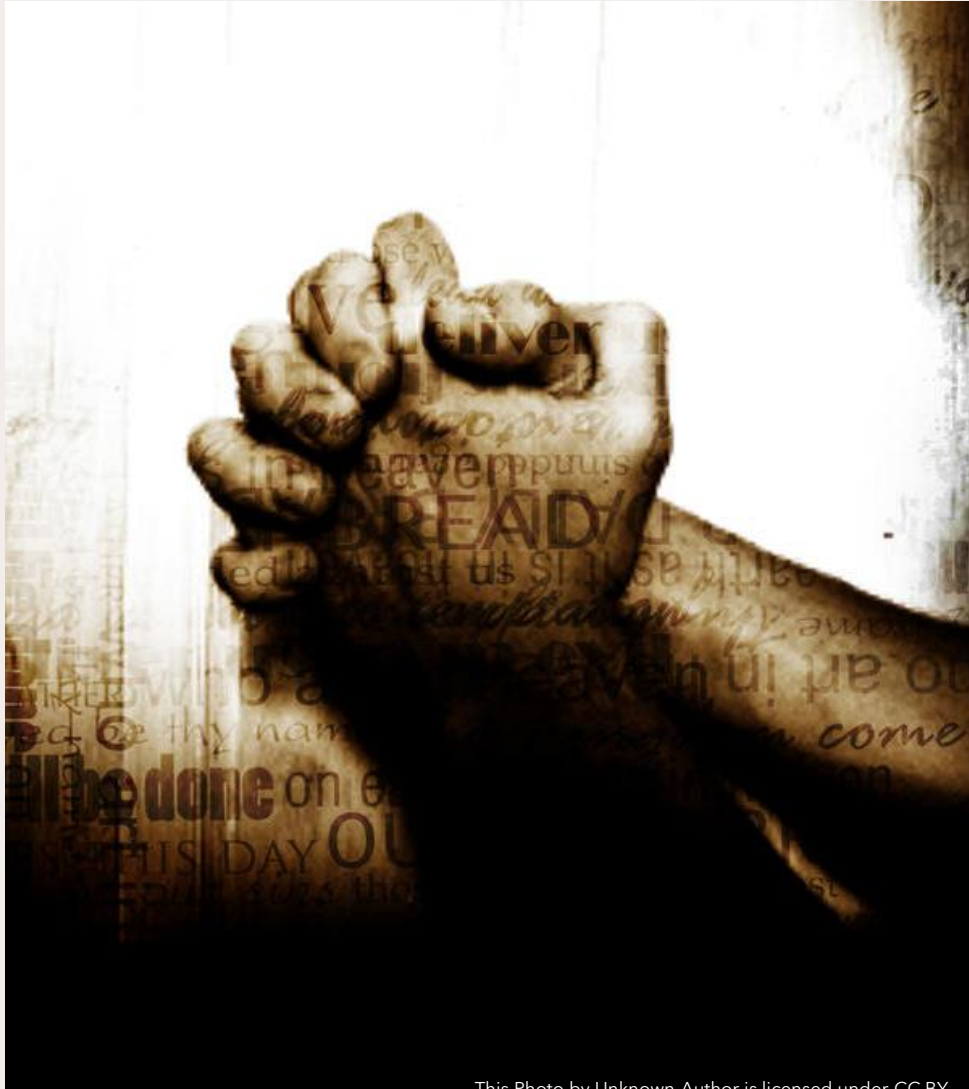

- Our anger should not be with these men.



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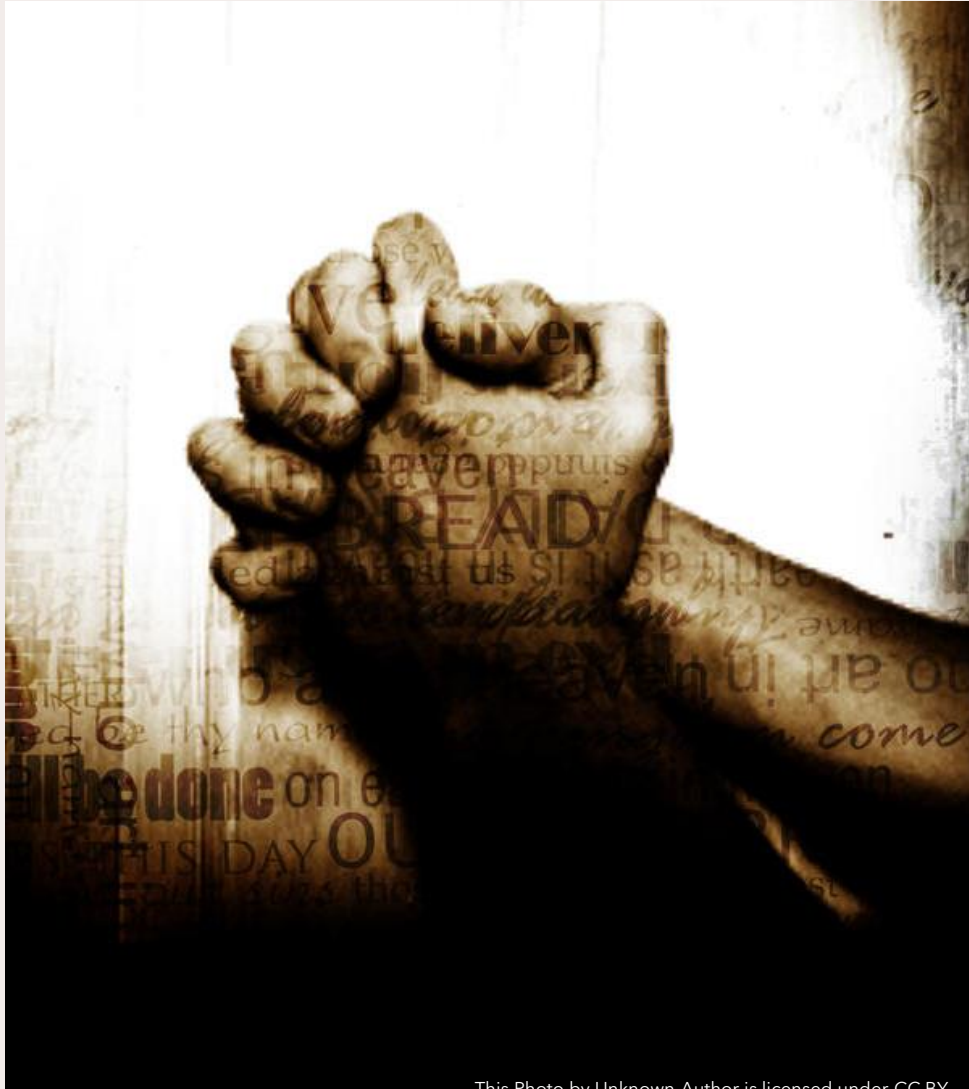
- Get your focus, and keep your focus, where it belongs, not on flesh and blood but on the powers, and authorities, the principalities and the forces of darkness.

- Standing firm is a prominent theme in the Scriptures.
- So prominent in fact, that you cannot ignore or deny it as the principal tactic of believers.

- Standing firm is a prominent theme in the Scriptures.
 - He also tells the Corinthians in 1Cor 16:1 to stand firm in faith.
 - Peter also tells the suffering church in 1 Peter 5:9 to stand firm in their faith.
 - Added to these are Psalm 89:28; Daniel 11:32, Galatians 5:1, Col 1:11, 1 Thes 3:8, 2 Thess 2:15.



THE FULL ARMOR OF GOD

Ephesians 6:14-19 Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one; and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints..."



THE FULL ARMOR OF GOD

1. The Belt of Truth – Demons cannot stand against the truth. Truth shines a penetrating light that dispels darkness. We have a group of politicians trying to take power by promoting lies. Loved ones, we must stand firm against that, and shine the light truth. Jesus, in John 8:32, ***“If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”***



THE FULL ARMOR OF GOD

2. **The Breastplate of Righteousness** – is the empowerment to have the clear ability to see between right and wrong, and act accordingly. To dawn ourselves with this breastplate, we must shed the garments of our Gentile life, and put on Christ. Isaiah 59:17 “***He put on righteousness as a breastplate, and a helmet of salvation on his head; he put on garments of vengeance for clothing, and wrapped himself in zeal as a cloak.***” Putting on righteousness DOES NOT MEAN living a perfect life. David, with all his sins, was a man after God’s own heart, because sought after God, and when he sinned he returned to God for forgiveness.

(See also 2 Cor 6:7 & 1 Thes 5:8)



THE FULL ARMOR OF GOD

3. Sandaled with readiness with the Gospel of PEACE

– Again, acquiring new territory is not an offensive move, it is stepping out and telling others about the Gospel. The new territory is a guarantee, because we are facing a defeated enemy. Standing firm in the territory is the objective. We turn to the commissioning of John the Baptizer: ***“And you, child, will be called the prophet of the Most High; for you will go before the Lord to prepare his ways, to give knowledge of salvation to his people in the forgiveness of their sins, because of the tender mercy of our God, whereby the sunrise shall visit us from on high to give light to those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.”***



THE FULL ARMOR OF GOD

4. THE SHIELD OF FAITH –In spiritual warfare, we too must link our shields and defend each other. This weapon of spiritual warfare enables us to stand firm as the darts of the devil are thrown at us.

Psalm 144:1-2 *“Blessed be the LORD, my rock, who trains my hands for war, and my fingers for battle; he is my steadfast love and my fortress, my stronghold and my deliverer, my shield and he in whom I take refuge, who subdues peoples under me.”*

(See also Ps 76:3)



THE FULL ARMOR OF GOD

5. THE HELMET OF SALVATION –

- This piece of armor involves the mind. Salvation is the turning point in our life on this side of Heaven. Salvation comes to us a gift, i.e., we are saved by the work of the Holy Spirit. Ephesians could not make that any clearer, “You are saved by Grace!” (Eph 2)
- When this occurs, the Holy Spirit takes up residence. At this moment, the demonic forces also go to work to establish strongholds in the mind causing us to question our salvation. The strongholds must be constantly torn down.
- If we do not pay attention to the battleground of the mind, we become weak and confused. The Theological Guide of Romans says, “***Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.***” (Romans 12:1-2) (See also 2 Cor 10:4 & Is 59:17)



THE FULL ARMOR OF GOD

6. The Sword of the Spirit –

- This is THE ONLY offensive weapon of spiritual warfare. Paul tells us this sword is the Word of God!
- This is a weapon that impacts the others.
 - It is the source of truth for the belt;
 - it is the compass of righteousness for the Breastplate;
 - it is the Good News of peace with God for the sandals;
 - it is the light of faith for the Shield;
 - it is the confirmation of salvation for the Helmet;
 - it is the enlightenment and power for our pray



THE FULL ARMOR OF GOD

6. The Sword of the Spirit –

2 Tim 3:16-17 “***All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.***”

Hebrews 4:12 “***For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.***”

(See also, Psalm 76:3 & 119:105, 2 Tim 3:17, Matt 10:34 [the sword Jesus brings is the truth of the word])



THE FULL ARMOR OF GOD

7. The Power of Prayer – Paul, tells us we must pray in the Spirit at all times. This includes all types of prayer: adoration, confession, and petitions.

This is so important that we are given 3 points of instruction:

- 1) Stay Alert:** The disciples failed to do this in the Garden of Gethsemane. Jesus, in fact, ask them, “Could you not stay awake with me for one hour?” (Matt 26:40-46; Mk 14:37-42; Lk 22:45-46.
- 2) Persevere:** Jesus told a parable about this. We must never give up on praying whether we see immediate results or not, never give up! (Lk 11:5-13; Lk 18:1-8; 1 Thes 5:17)

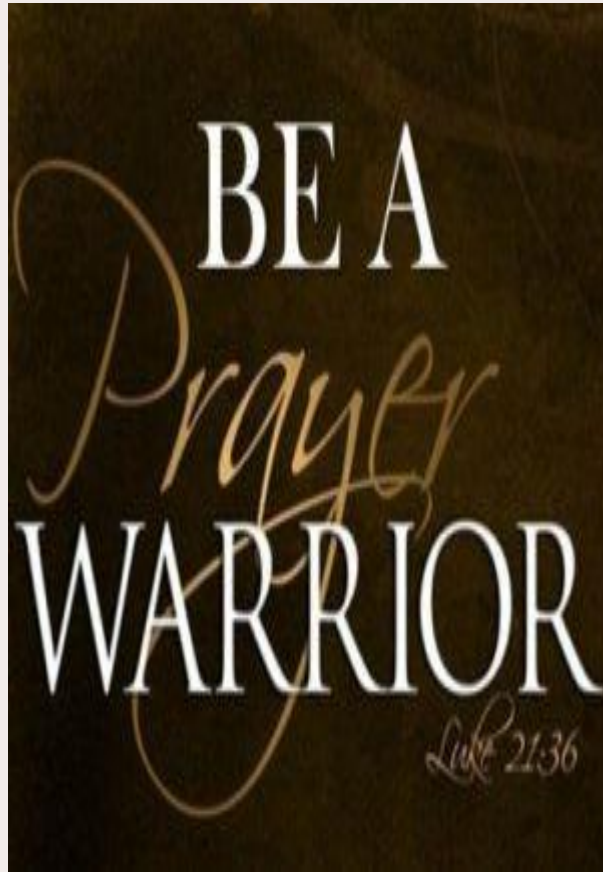

7. The Power of Prayer –

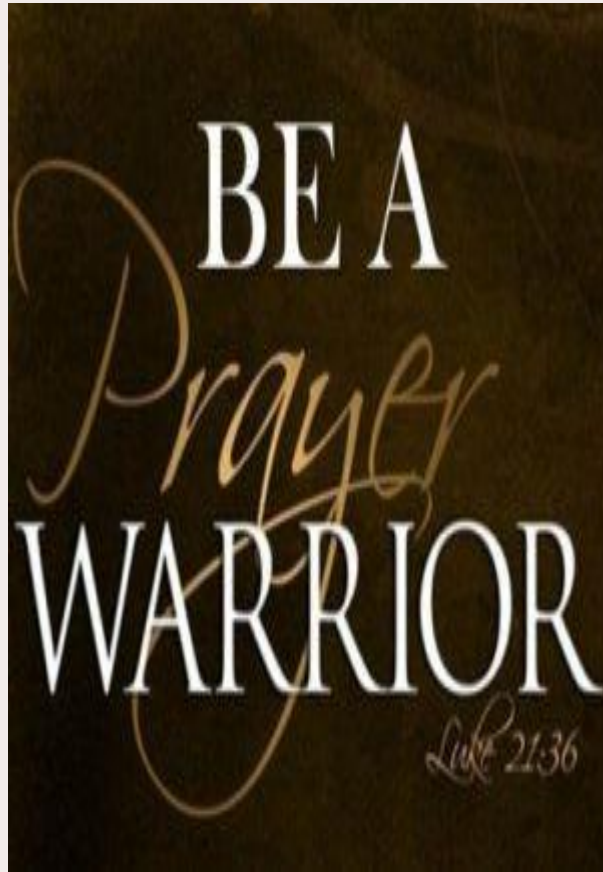
3) Intercede: Over and over we are told to pray for others. This is the core of spiritual warfare. Paul said, in 1 Cor 14:15, “*I will pray with my spirit, and I will pray with my mind.*” Paul has a prayer language, where he prays in tongues, and he has a prayer language in his dominate language. The predominant prayer called for in Scripture, is to pray in your dominate language. Paul even says in 1 Cor 13, that without interpretation, praying in tongues should not be done in public.

(See also 1 Sam 12:19; Ps 122:6; Is 53:12; Jer 42:2; Matt 5:44; Lk 6:28; Rom 8:26; Phil 1:4; Col 1:3 & 9; 2 Thes 1:11; 1 Tim 2:1; Heb 7:25; James 5:14 & 16)



PAUL'S FINAL WORDS

Eph 6:19-20 “(Pray)...*also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains, that I may declare it boldly, as I ought to speak.*”

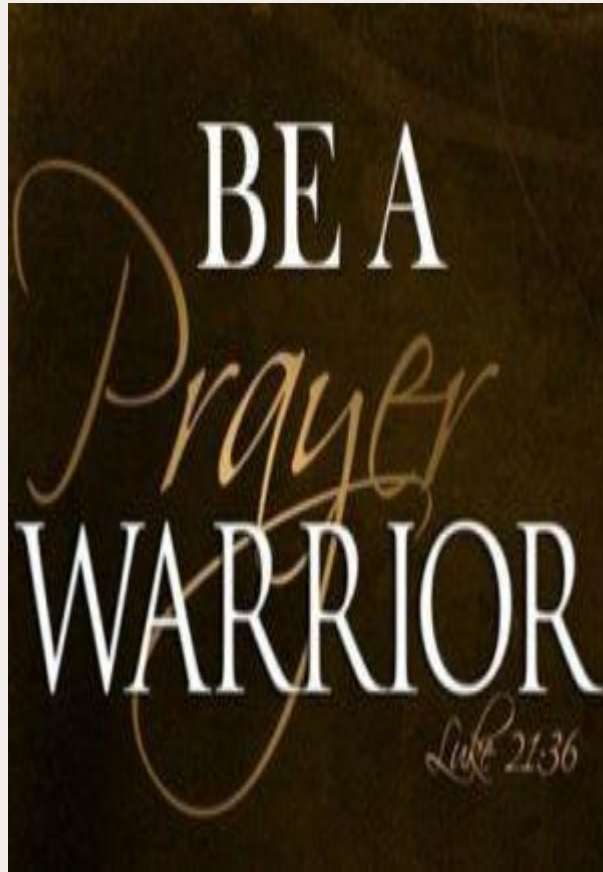


PAUL'S FINAL WORDS

By requesting this prayer for himself, Paul is conveying two points.

1) Paul is asking for boldness to speak up for the Gospel.

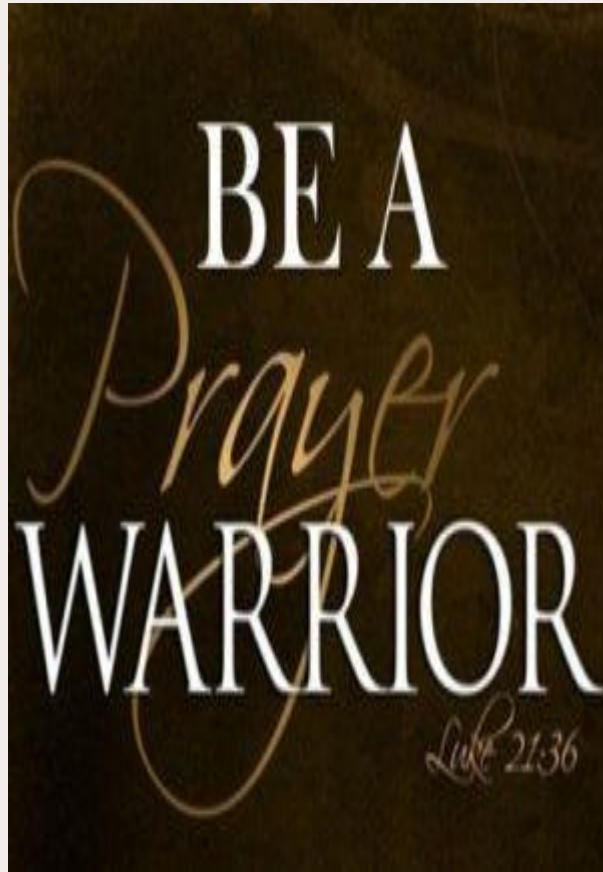
- This is a prayer petition that should be regularly on our lips. Paul also makes this request for boldness in Eph 3:13; 1 Thes 2:2; and 2 Cor 3:12.
- We also hear the disciples pray for boldness to speak the Gospel in Acts 4:29-31. When they finished praying the room where they were praying began shaking.
- In this culture in which we live, it takes boldness to speak the Gospel. Ridicule is not far from us when we speak, **BUT WE MUST NOT** be timid. Ridicule is a tool of the demonic to keep us timid. If remain timid, this generation, already on a tough road, will be lost. **BE BOLD!!**



PAUL'S FINAL WORDS

By requesting this prayer for himself, Paul is conveying two points.

2) Paul is reminding us we are Ambassadors for Christ. Paul uses this title twice in his letters. Here in Ephesians and in 2 Corinthians 5:20-6:1. The Corinthians' text is important. It clearly tells who we represent as ambassadors, and what we are to speak as ambassadors. An ambassador DOES NOT speak their own words. An ambassador is representing someone other than him/herself.



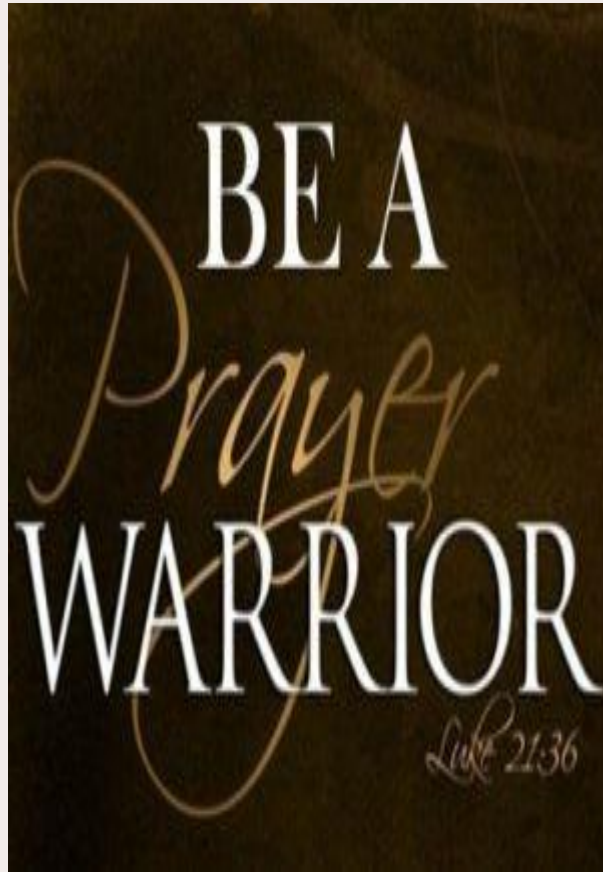

By requesting this prayer for himself, Paul is conveying two points.

2) Paul is reminding us we are Ambassadors for Christ.

- There are two important implications here:
 - a) *when we are criticized for speaking boldly, we should not take it personally.*

Jesus told us that too in **Luke 10:16** ***“The one who hears you hears me, and the one who rejects you rejects me, and the one who rejects me rejects him who sent me.”***



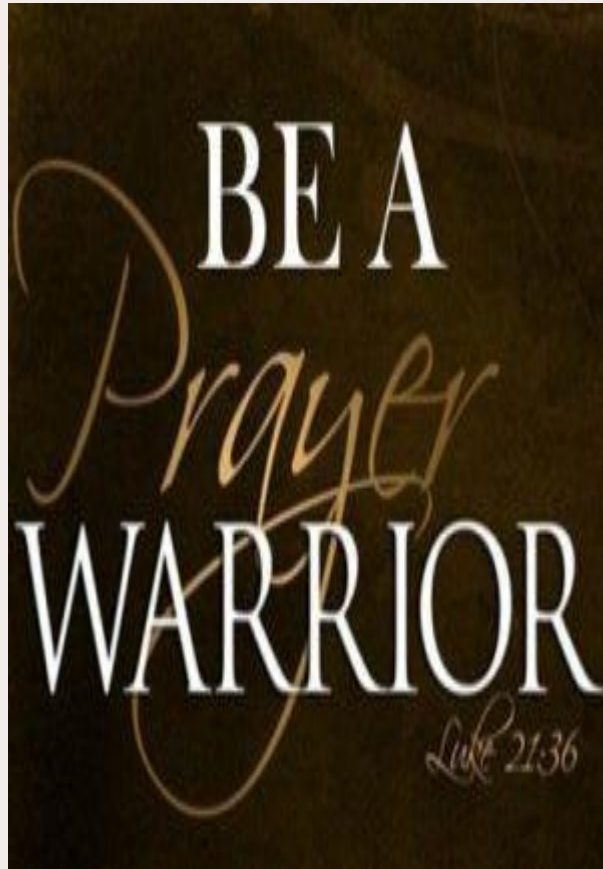
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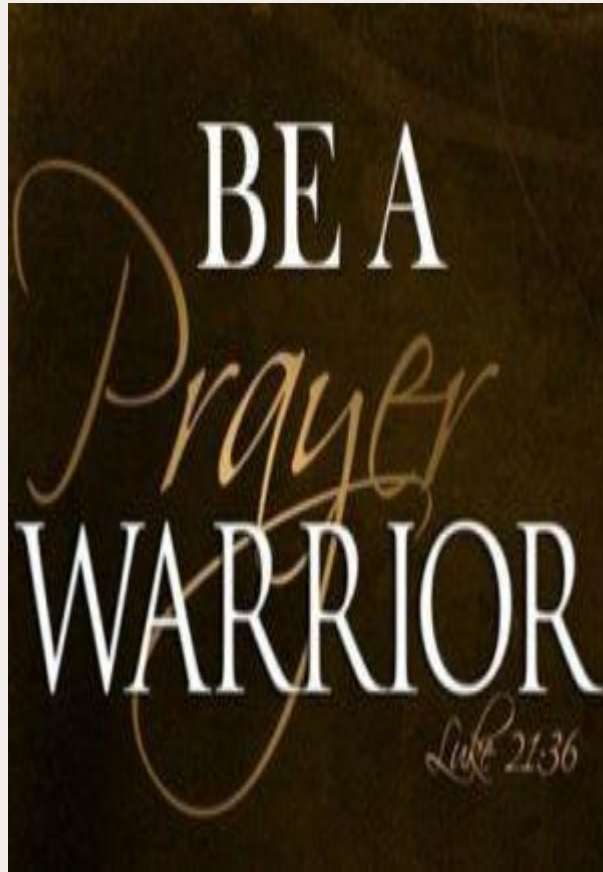
b) The title ambassador reminds us this is not our land. Both Paul and Peter wanted the followers of Christ to understand this clearly. This has always been very hard for Americans because our government is one that sets people free. Still, Paul in Phil 3:20 tells us our citizenship is in heaven, NOT HERE. Peter uses the word “exiles” in 1 Peter 1:1, 17, & 2:11 to remind us this is not our land. Therefore, we should not get too caught up in worldly systems of government. Instead. We must be able to work within whatever system of government we find ourselves.

We've reached the end!

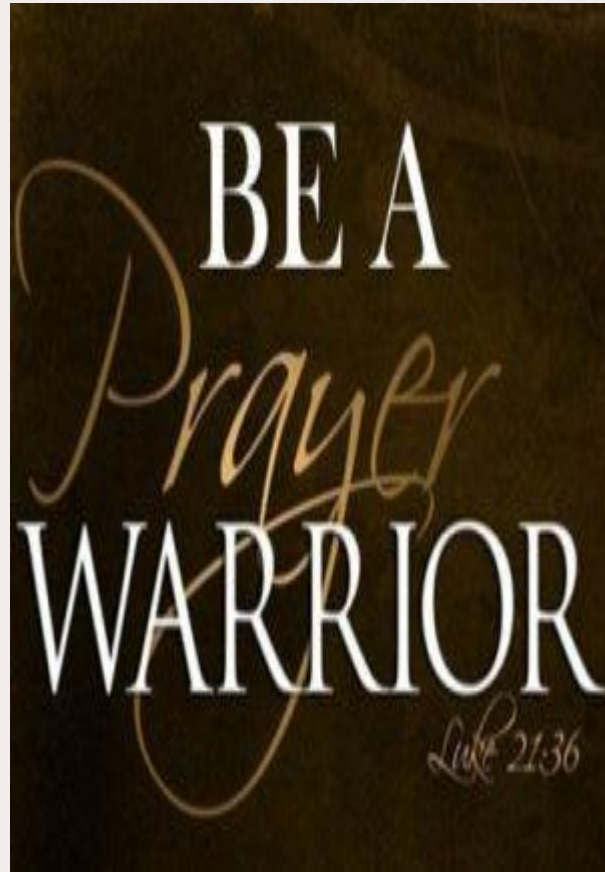

- But he reserves his blessing of “Grace,” i.e., the blessing of empowerment for living, for those with undying love for Christ
