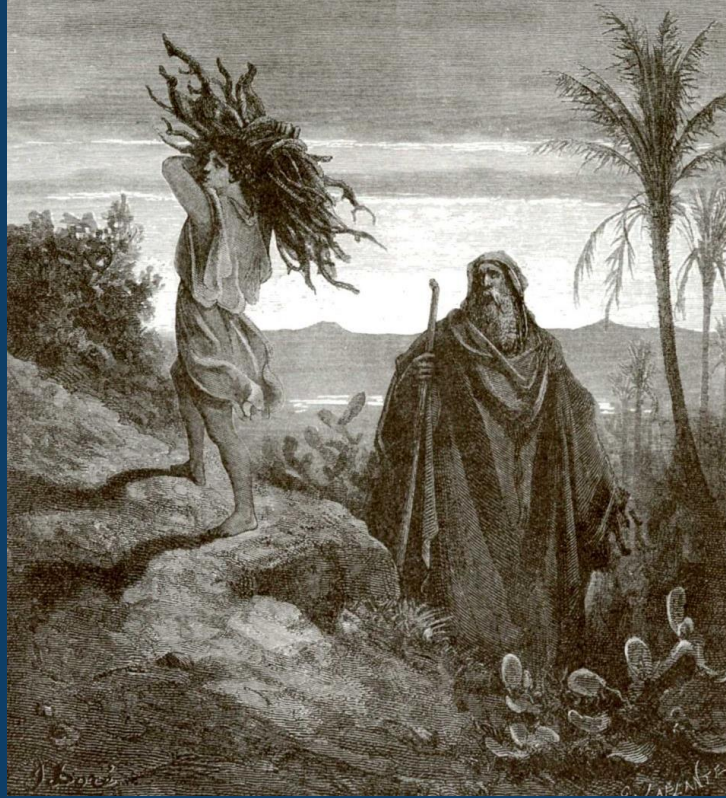

Genesis 15:4 - 6

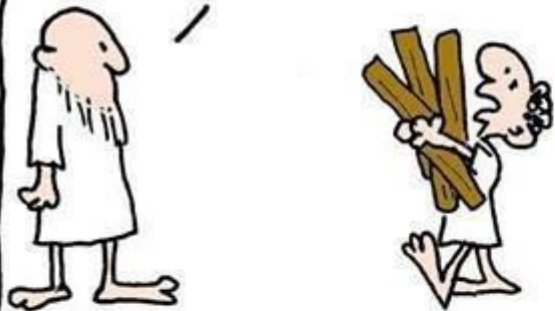

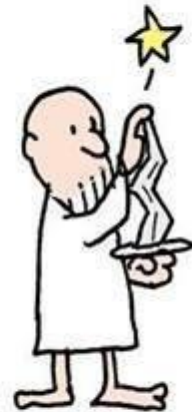

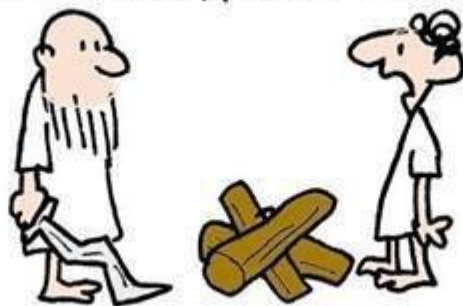
