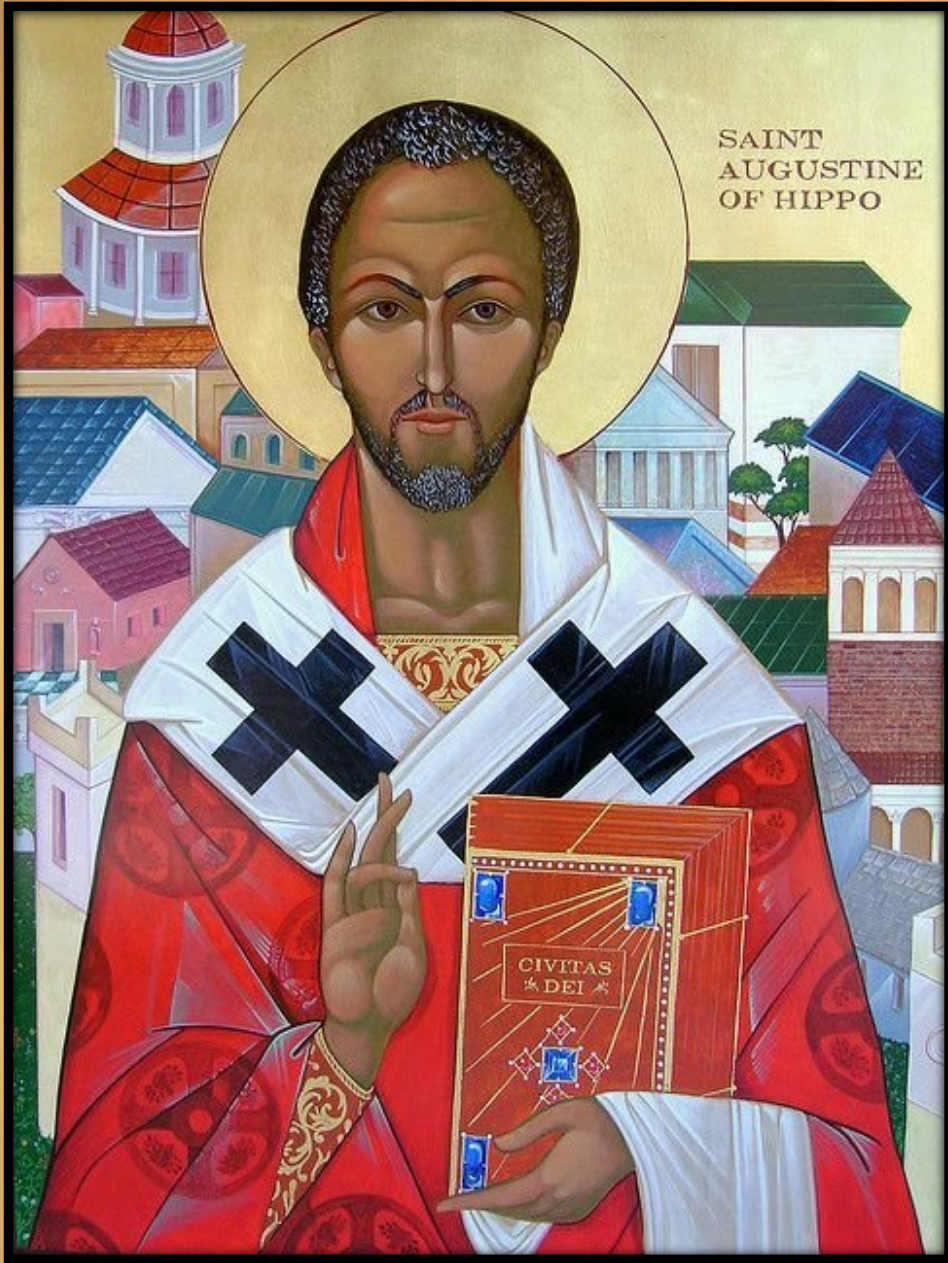

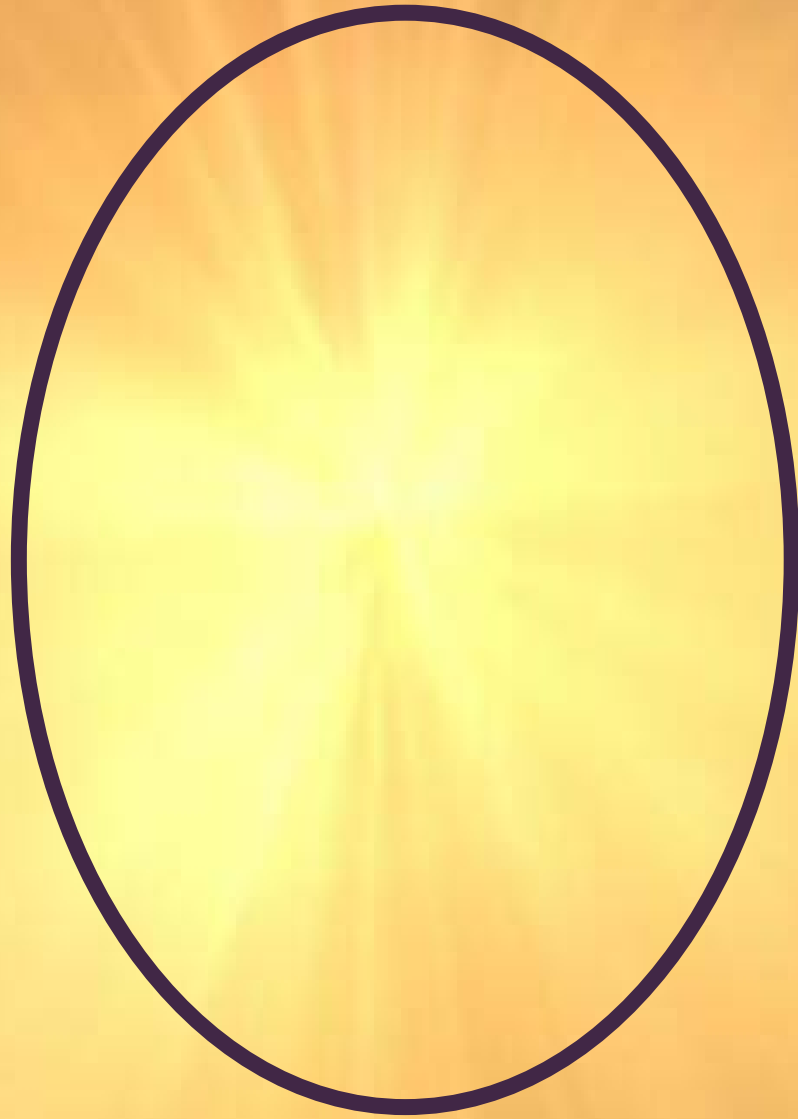

The Face of God



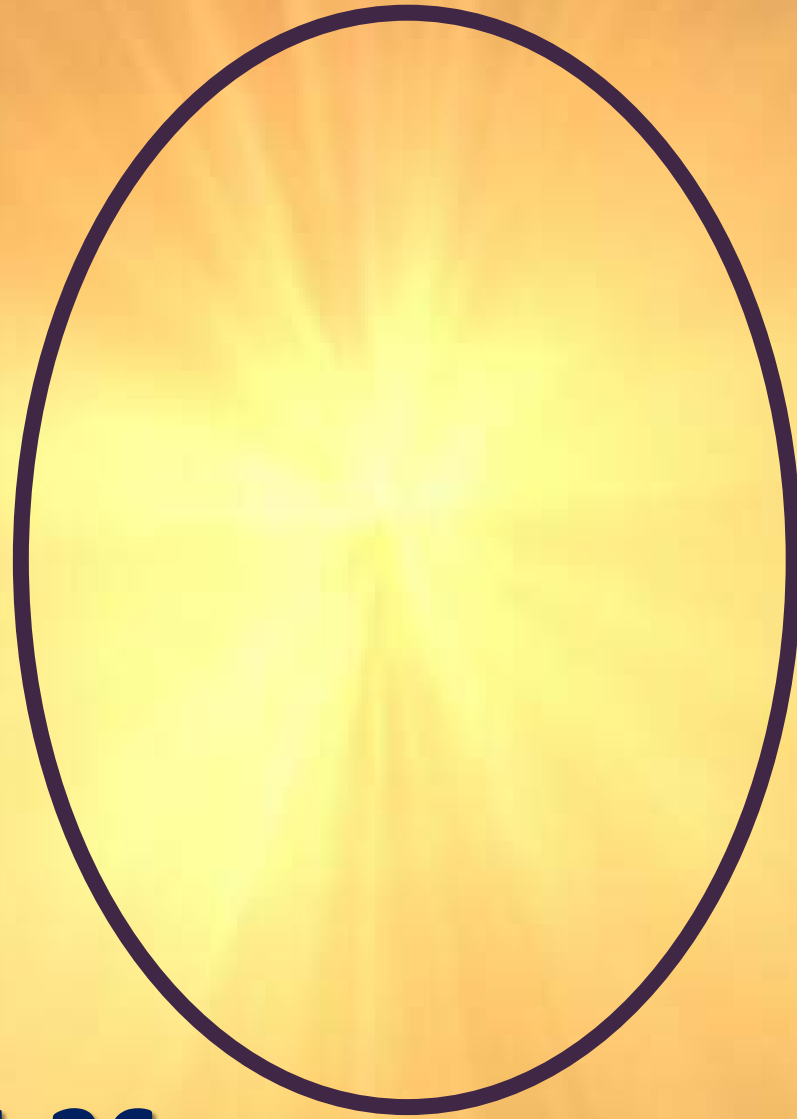
**If we walk in the light, as he is in the light,

and the truth is not in us.**

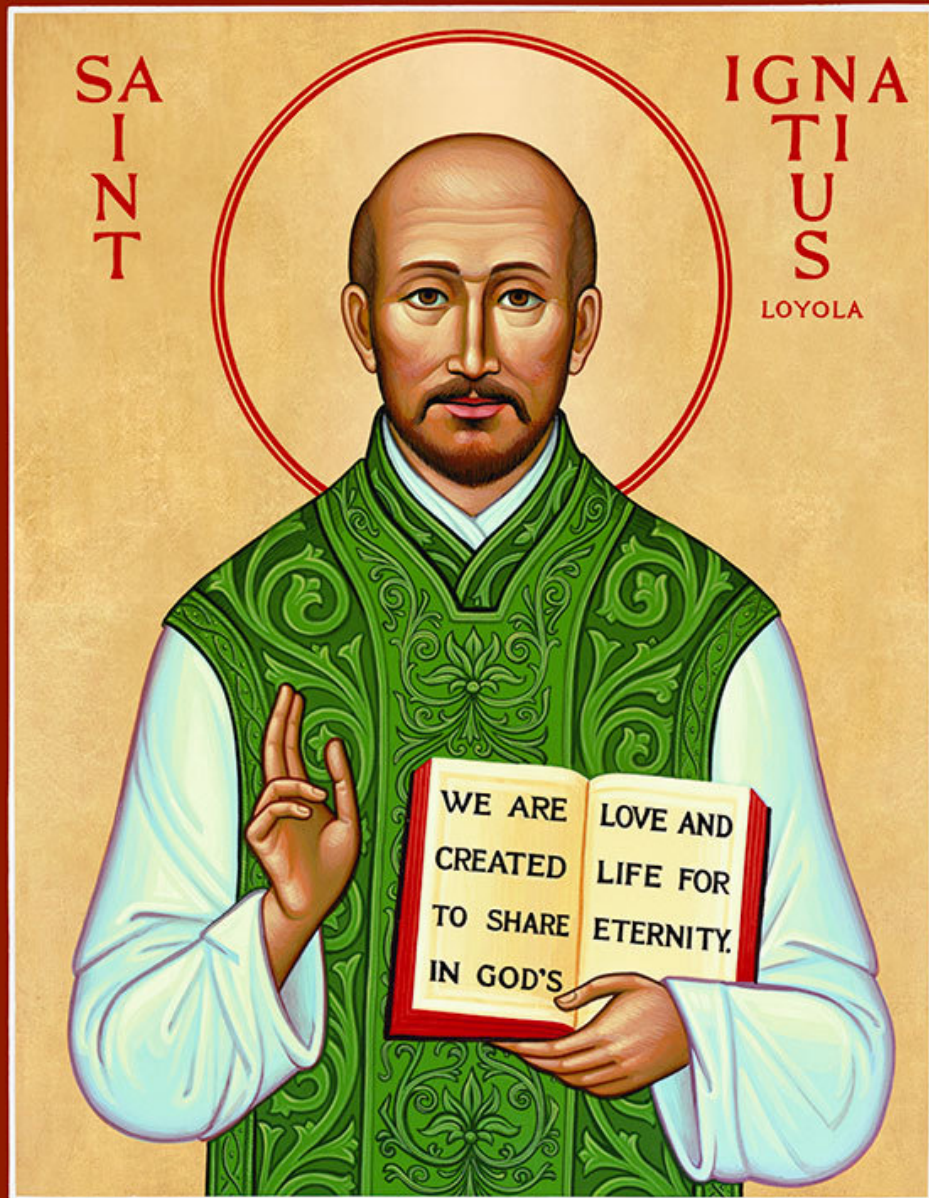
**If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just
